1. The 18th Edition Mindanao Milo Little Olympics will be conducted on August 8 - 10, 2014 at the Gregorio A. Pelaez Sports Center, Cagayan de Oro City. The Athletic Parade and Opening Program will be on August 8, 2014 at 12:00 noon assembly area at Pelaez Sports Center parade will start at exactly 1:00 in the afternoon. The event shall be participated in by elementary and secondary pupil/student athletes from the different schools in Mindanao.

2. To avoid disruption of classes, games will be done during Saturday and Sunday, August 9-10, 2014. In case games cannot be finished in two days, a continuation of the said games will be done on August 16, 2014. 3. Passport – for foreigner athlete submit original passport with one photo copy if qualified to national finals still original passport is needed.
4. Bio-data and waiver is officially indicated upon registration.
5. Form 137 is required – however, the principal will certify that the athletes are enrolled for the school year 2014-2015.
6. Medical Doctors should print their names with signature in the registration/waiver form of the athletes.
7. Every athlete is required to attach at least 1 empty 22g pack of MILO.
8. Conforme Sheet should be accomplished accordingly.

2. **A SCHOOL MUST ENTER IN A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) SPORTING EVENTS PER LEVEL IN ORDER TO BE ACCEPTED IN THE MLO.**
3. Knock down system is to be applied in sporting games (Basketball, Badminton, Football, Lawn Tennis, Scrabble, Sepaktakraw, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, and Volleyball). Athletics and Swimming events shall be based on Best Times. The Gymnastics event shall implement its standard scoring system and Chess shall use the Swiss system.
4. Registration form shall be duly accomplished and signed by the Principal/ Registrar with school seal.
5. Registration fees:

- b. Participants in 3 events
 - 10 Delegation Officials
 - number of Athletes
 - number of coaches/Trainer
 - Based on the list submitted by the secretariat
 - 2 flag bearers and 1 muse

3. Order of Parade

- Elementary school participants - heads of school will submit names of officials joining the parade for recognition
- Secondary school participants
- Parade committee in charge

4. 100 meters starting point for the contests up to the finishing lines.

5. Marching in cadence with choreograph movements up to the finishing lines without stopping at the center.

6. Field formations

- 1 single line for few participants
- 2 lines for more participants
- 3 and 4 lines for many participants

7. All contests will be judged by the Board of Judges.

1. **Loudest Cheer by School** – Separate Elementary and High School
2. **Biggest School Delegation** – Separate Elementary and High School
3. **Best in Marching with Saludo** – Separate Elementary and High School
Only (2) Minutes allowed from the Starting Area to the Finishing Line deductions of 10 points for any violation (NO STOPPING RULE)
4. **Most Discipline School Team** – Assembled inside the track oval
5. **CHEERDANCE COMPETITION** – Separate Elementary and Secondary.
With Registration Fee of Php 1,000.00 each
6. **MISS MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS** – Separate Elementary and Secondary.
Attire: White Tennis Sports for Elementary
Green Tennis Sports for Secondary
7. **CHEERERS IN THE MAIN GRANSTAND**
 - A. The management will provide spaces in the main grandstand for the cheerers based on the number of cheers submitted by the heads of school - PNP / ROTC Cadets are assigned as controllers.
 - B. Entrance are north and south gates to be opened at 11:00 pm.
 - C. Assigned cheers are requested to wear school uniform and ID's with Teacher Assigned for discipline.
 - D. Parents and others are provided also enough space.

VIII. All Technical Rules are the same as of last year, except for Basketball, Football and Volleyball are limited to 16 Teams only. Registration of the 3 events will be done in first come first serve bases with complete documents and fees needed. Dimension of football playing area Elementary 9x9x15x15, high school - the same last year.

Poise Bearing and Personality	40%
Sports Attire	10%

Mechanics:

1. The contest is open to all FEMALE student of the participating schools of MILO Little Olympics 2014
2. She must be at least 7 - 12 years old height 4'8" and above cut off year is 2002 for the elementary. For High School is 17 years old and height 5'2" and above and cut off year is 1997.
3. Must attend the rehearsals scheduled by the chairman.
4. An endorsement from the heads of school must be submitted to the Secretariat Office with candidate Resume during registration.
5. The use of False eye lashes, wigs (Hair Extensions), jewelries and heavy make up during the finals is strictly prohibited.
6. Wearing of sandals and high heeled shoes during the competition is strictly prohibited. Candidates must wear rubber shoes.
7. A five point deduction will be imposed to those who will violate the guidelines nos. 6 and 7.
8. Presentation of arrangement of candidates will be determined by the chairman of contest through the drawing of lots.
9. Candidates in the elementary division must wear a dominant WHITE TENNIS Sports Attire and Candidates in the secondary division must wear a dominant GREEN TENNIS Sport Attire.
10. Decision of judges is final and non-appealable. Absolutely no participants / contestants' representative shall be allowed to contact in any manner whatsoever any judge with the intention of questioning the BOARD OF JUDGES announced decision.
12. Winners will be awarded immediately to be assisted by the parents.

Note: The chairman will prepare a written sequence on the contest for guidance by the hosts.

BILLETING QUARTERS HOUSE RULES OF THE MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS MINDANAO 2014

1. ALWAYS WEAR MILO ID ALL THE TIME. REMEMBER **“NO ID, NO ENTRY/PLAY TO PLAYING VENUES”**.
2. ATHLETES ARE **STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM SMOKING AND DRINKING LIQUOR** AS WELL AS THE SCHOOL OFFICIALS.
3. TAKE CARE OF YOUR PERSONAL BELONGINGS; THE SCHOOLS OFFICIAL WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST VALUABLE THAT MAY OCCUR DURING THE PERIOD OF THEIR STAY.
4. AVOID MAKING SCANDALOUS NOISE SO AS NOT TO DISTURB OTHER ATHLETES IN NEIGHBORING ROOM.
5. **VANDALISM and LITTERING ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
6. **GOING OUT OF THE QUARTER AFTER CURFEW HOUR IS STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED.** INDIVIDUAL ID WILL BE DEPOSITED AT THE SCHOOL SECURITY / GUARDS.
7. **NO COOKING INSIDE THE SCHOOL PREMISES and CLASSROOMS.**
8. NO VISITORS/OUTSIDERS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE SCHOOL CAMPUS/ROOMS. FOR PARENTS WHO ARE REQUESTING TO VISIT THEIR SONS/DAUGHTERS, AN INTERVIEW WILL BE DONE BY THE SECURITY FORCE IN CHARGE.
9. DAMAGE OF ROOM PROPERTY WILL BE PAID BY THE ROOM OCCUPANTS BEFORE THEY WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE SCHOOL PREMISES – **MOA** WILL BE MADE BETWEEN THE IN CHARGE OF THE SCHOOL AND THE COACH OF THE TEAM. THE ASSIGNED TEACHER WILL EVALUATE THE COST OF DAMAGE AND TEMPORARY RECEIPT SHOULD BE SIGNED BY BOTH PARTIES, COPY FURNISHED THE SECRETARIAT.
