**2014 DIVISION LEVEL DEPEDNOMICS SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AND  
COMPETITION AND TLE/TVE TECHNOLYMPICS**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No.458, s. 2009 re: "Strengthening Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP) Curriculum," and Regional Memorandum No.67, s. 2011 re: "DepEdnomics: Region 10 Towards Food Sufficiency and Entrepreneurship Program," and unnumbered Regional Memorandum dated May 8, 2013 re: "Regional Integrated Competition", this division will conduct the DepEdnomics Skills Development and Competition and TLE/TVE Technolympics on October 10, 2014 at Opol National Secondary Technical School (ONSTS), Opol, Misamis Oriental as venue for both secondary and elementary level.
2. The contestants/participants in the division level DepEdnomics Skills Development are the first place winners of the identified skills in the district level skills competition. The members of the division DepEdnomics management committee, district supervisors, district/high school coordinators, elementary principals/headteachers, secondary administrators, coaches, trainers, and advisers of the pupil/student delegates are authorized to attend the skills development and competition.
3. Pupil/Student participants shall be given enough time to prepare for quizzes and other examinations missed during the conduct of the skills development and competition and TLE/TVE Technolympics. Pupil/student participants shall also be allowed reasonable time to comply with and submit other requirements of the different subject areas.
4. **No registration of all participants of the said activity.**
5. Travelling expenses of participants and contest administrators/facilitators are chargeable against school MOOE/local/school board funds, while the prizes/awards/plaques/certificates, supplies and materials of the skills to be competed is charged to division funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations. It is advised that the P.T.A and non-government funds and other funding sources be tapped for financial assistance.
6. To ensure a standard implementation of the skills development and competition, the list of contest administrators/facilitators, the general guidelines, and skills contest package are attached as enclosures no. 1, 2, and 3 respectively.

7. The list of delegation officials and contestants must be submitted to Mr. Norberto E. Rosales, EPS-I on or before October 2, 2014.
8. All contestants, through their respective coaches are required to submit the following documents during the contest administration.
  - a. Certified photocopy of the 137, at least Second Grading Grades are reflected.
  - b. School Principal's Certificate of the contest enrolment during the present year, including certification as to his membership in the STEP school organization.
  - c. Recent 2x2 picture attached to Form 137.
  - d. Official School ID (Photocopy).
  - e. Contestant must be certified to be in good health.
  - f. Parent's permit.
