

1. Pursuant to Deped Order No. 86, s. 2012, re: Guidelines on Revitalizing Girl Scouting in Schools Nationwide and BSP Council Memorandum No. 3, s. 2013, this Office recognizes and promotes scouting through **JOINT BSP AND GSP SIMULTANEOUS DISTRICT CAMPORAL 2014** on October 14-15, 2014.
2. Participation to the said camporal requires the following:
