1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 19, s.2014, the 2014 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) with the theme "Campus Journalism and Transformational Leadership" will be on April 7-10, 2014 at Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) Free Port Zone, Olongapo City.
2. Participants to the 2014 NSPC are the top three (3) winners of the Regional Cluster Schools Press Conference for the individual writing contest, first place winners of the Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting, Collaborative Publishing Contest and their advisers, both elementary and secondary, English and Filipino categories, Education Program Supervisors, Division Journalism Coordinator, Schools Division Superintendent.
3. Please be informed also that there is an individual writing contest on Science and Health. Thus, the 4<sup>th</sup> and the 5<sup>th</sup> place winners of the Feature Writing and the 4<sup>th</sup> place winners of the newswriting in elementary and secondary, English and Filipino will be the official contestants for the Science and Health Writing Contest.
4. Contestants are required to bring their school ID, medical certificate that they are physically fit to join the contest, parental permit and if they wish to join the educational tour, a separate parent's permit is required. No parent's permit, no educational tour.
5. Enclosed is the list of participants and qualifiers to the said conference.
6. Traveling and other expenses including the registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (P 4,000.00) shall be charged against School MOOE, SEF subject to the approval of the local executives or Campus Journalism Funds subject to the availability of funds. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Payment for the registration fee shall be paid in cash.
