The Patrol Leaders and Crew Leaders Training Courses aim to demonstrate typical scout activities and the need for intelligent coordination of efforts through leadership, underlying the necessity for discipline and good order, demonstrate the technique of " learning by doing" by the immediate application of newly acquired Scouting skills , and give as many scouts as possible the experience of leadership..
