Search for Most Outstanding Coach of the Philippines (Science and Mathematics)

Qualifications:

1. Must have been a Science/Mathematics coach.
2. Able to compete at least in the Division Level Science or Math related Competitions.
3. Must be of good moral character.
4. Must be nominated by the school head/department head.
5. Duly recommended by any of the following: Elementary-District Supervisor, Secondary-School Principal, Tertiary- Administrator, College/university President

Guidelines:

1. The candidate shall submit a portfolio with the following content:
 - a. Information sheet with Nomination Form
 - b. Duly certified true copy of his/her Certificates from the school authorized personnel or the District Supervisor for the elementary, secondary-School Principal, tertiary- Dean/HRD.
2. The certificates shall cover the period from January 2007 to July 2014 only. However, we also welcome previous outstanding accomplishments if it seems very necessary.
3. Certificates and outstanding accomplishments should be written in a summary sheet (pls. find below).
4. The deadline of submission will be on August 30, 2014.
5. The National Evaluation Committee will evaluate all the documents submitted and determine the Regional Winners. The regional winners will be included as National Finalists for the search of MOCP. They will be informed thru text or email.
6. The National Evaluation Committee may require the finalist to bring the original certificates for validation.
7. Finalist are encourage to attend the International Conference on Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) in the Context of K to 12 Curriculum on October 22-24, 2014 at Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan, where the final interview will also be held.
8. Portfolio must be mailed to: Jasper Pastrano, WVCST, La Paz, Iloilo City

Awards:

1. The Regional Winners and the school they represent will receive a Certificate of Recognition.
2. Winners of the Most Outstanding Coach of the Philippines will receive a Certificate of Merit and a medal, while the school will receive a Certificate of Recognition.
