1. The United Nations General Assembly adopted United Nations Resolution 2782 declaring United Nations Day shall be an International Day and in 1947 declared October 24 the Anniversary of the Charter of the United Nations.

2. To commemorate this event, the Department of Education (DepED) Division of Misamis Oriental will be joining the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the UN Assembly declaration with the theme depicts: **“THE RIGHT OF PEOPLES TO PEACE.”**

3. The celebration of the United Nations aims to:

- Invite Peoples to honor a cessation of hostilities through education and public awareness on issues related to peace.
- Appreciate the significance of unity and solidarity among nations regardless of color and identity, customs and traditions.

- People Power Video on non-violent resistance strategies
- Quiz Bee
- Showcase Music, Art, Dances, Dasang and Rituals of the Higaonons
- Invite a Higaonon Tribal Chieftain to serve as Guest Speaker during the culminating program.
- Reading the United Nations and Universal Peace Federation statements about the International Day of Peace (classroom)
- Observing one minute of silence (during culminating program)
