Girl Scouts **SAVER** is a special service program undertaken by a team of Girl Scouts and Non-Girl Scout volunteers organized to assist in times of emergency. It stands for **Service Auxiliary Volunteers for Emergency and Relief**. Purpose of this training is to equip our senior girl scouts/troop leaders during emergency/calamities especially on relief operations and their understanding on disaster preparedness and skills to identify and respond to situations or calamities through psychosocial response and processing.

Once again this will be conducted by expert Trainers /Volunteers from Cagayan de Oro City Rescue Team, DSWD and GSP Trainers.

 (Organization of teams will be done after the training and will be reported to the DSWD Office for recognition)
- Qualifications** : **Physically Fit**
- Schedule of Activities:** 7:30-8:00 –Arrival & Registration
 8:30 a.m. – Opening Ceremony
- Registration** : P 600.00 /participant- for badges, meals & snacks, training fee & certificate, venue -can be charge to MOEE subject to the usual auditing and accounting procedures.




