**We would like to invite you and members of your staff to join us in the 8<sup>th</sup> Magiting Conference “Malay Natin: Kabataang Magiting sa Nagbabagong Panahon” on March 4, 2023, Saturday, 1:30-4pm at the Centrio Mall Cinema 1, Cagayan De Oro City.**

Ayala Foundation, through its Maging Magiting program, advocates love of country and recognizes that every Filipino has it in them to be heroes. A key component of the program is the Magiting Conference, a series of thought-provoking conversations and informative and entertaining presentations, to awaken participants’ deep love for their country while also inspiring them to transform this deep love into meaningful action.

As the Philippines celebrates its 125<sup>th</sup> year of Independence and Nationhood, Ayala Foundation commits to organize three Magiting Conferences drawing inspiration from the theme of the national commemoration – “Kalayaan. Kinabukasan. Kasaysayan.”

The first of the series is entitled “Malay Natin: Kabataang Magiting sa Nagbabagong Panahon.” *Malay Natin* is a play on the popular Filipino phrase that expresses optimism amidst doubt. It can also be literally roughly translated as “our consciousness,” highlighting that the Magiting Conference is a conversation on what we know and unearthing what we do not know about the role of the youth – past and present, in fighting for our independence.

Our speakers for this event are Professor Maris Diokno, Professor Emerita of the Department of History in University of the Philippines Diliman, and Director Jerrold Tarog, director, screenwriter, producer, best known for his works *Heneral Luna* and *Goyo*. The conversation will be moderated by PJ Hernandez, or The Traveling Salakot, a social science teacher who offers free history tours around Manila.
