In view of the disseminated DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 033, s. 2023, dated 31 May 2023, titled **Learners' Convergence PH 2023**, with the theme, *SaMakabata: Sentro ng Karunungan, Huwaran ng Kagalingan*, from **July 29 to August 3, 2023**, in Marikina City, Metro Manila, the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Operations (OASOPS), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD), transitioning to Learner Formation Division, issues the following advisory to provide the following information on administrative matters relative to the conduct of the activity.

Kindly take note of the following schedule and administrative details prior to and during the activity:

1. Check-in date of participants to their designated billeting schools shall be on **Saturday, 29 July 2023** and the first meal to be served is **lunch**; while the check-out of participants shall be on **Thursday, 03 August 2023 until 12:00 noon**, with **breakfast** as the last meal. Any arrangements not covered as indicated shall be charged to the participant's account. Below are the billeting schools for your reference:

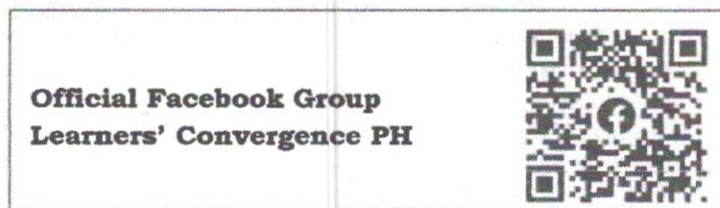
2. Participants traveling by air or by sea may be picked up at the airport terminal upon arrival by their coordinated transportation providers. shall be made by the participating SDOs before coming to the venue. Meanwhile, participants traveling by land shall proceed directly to their assigned billeting schools and will be accommodated by the Welcoming Committee. Travel expenses shall be charged accordingly with the provisions in compliance with DM 033 S. 2023 subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

3. In compliance with the existing health and safety protocols, all participants are required to bring their COVID-19 vaccination cards, parental consent and waiver form, and valid identification cards and/or school IDs during the entire activity.
4. Considering the issuance of Executive Order No. 7, s. 2022 titled, *Allowing Voluntary Wearing of Face Masks in Indoor and Outdoor Settings, Reiterating the Continued Implementing of Minimum Public Health Standards during the State of Public Health Emergency relative to COVID-19 Pandemic*, we highly encourage everyone to wear face masks during the whole duration of the activity except when eating or drinking.
5. Participants exhibiting any flu-like symptoms including fever, cough, sore throat or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches and chills, headaches, or fatigue are strongly discouraged to join the event. In the same manner, participants who have already checked-in but are exhibiting symptoms listed above while the activities are ongoing will not be allowed to be with other participants and will be subject to necessary medical assistance.



8. All participants shall follow all house rules and regulations prescribed by the LearnConPH Secretariat and their respective billeting schools. During the attendance at the Palarong Pambansa (PP) 2023 Opening Ceremonies on July 31, participants are advised to strictly adhere to the protocols set by the PP Secretariat. This is to ensure that every participant is compliant, safe, secured, and far from any form of danger during the actual program. A separate advisory on PP participation will be shared immediately once formalized.

9. On August 01, 2023 (Simultaneous Sessions), participants will be divided into five (5) groups based on their representation to attend the following simultaneous sessions. The two (2) chaperones shall be designated to venues outside Marikina Convention Center (MCC) to assist their participants namely Ingenium School Quadrangle (for School Sports Division session) and Infant Jesus Academy (for DRRMS session).
 - BLSS-YFD Session (outgoing and incoming DFSSLG Presidents)

- BLSS-SHD Session (health organization learner representatives)
 - BLSS-SSD Session (sports organization learner representatives)
 - DRRMS Session (DRRM organization learner representatives)
 - LRPO Session (CPC member or LRP organization learner representatives)
10. On August 2, each region has 5 minutes (1-minute entry, 3 minutes real performance, 1-minute exit) to showcase any form of performance (dance and/or song numbers, acting, etc.) during the Convergence Night and Closing Ceremonies. Also, each region is highly encouraged to bring their corresponding **regional banner** for the entry of colors.
 11. Each participant will be provided with sleeping materials including a mattress, pillow, and blanket sponsored by the LGU (Local Government Unit) Marikina. Materials will be set up beforehand in each billeting school. Participants may or may not bring additional sleeping materials.
 12. In support of Marikina City's initiatives to purchase products and services that cause minimal adverse environmental impacts, all participants are encouraged to bring their own tumblers and eating utensils (particularly metal or bamboo spoons and forks) to lessen plastic waste.
 13. In addition, everyone is also encouraged to bring the following items to be used all throughout the Convergence:
 - Laptop/tablet/mobile devices and extension cords for workshops and personal use
 - 1 metal or plastic whistle (*pito*) for emergency purposes
 - 1 raincoat in case of inclement weather
 - 1 triangular flaglet for the organized tour (blue for participants, green for chaperones)
 - personal hygiene items and toiletries including, but not limited to, hair care products (shampoo and conditioner), bath soap and towel, comb, etc.
 - prescribed medications if there are any
 14. Participants shall observe cleanliness and orderliness at all times. All are expected to adopt the "clean as you go (CLAYGO) policy" especially when eating at the plenary venue and their respective mess halls, and the use of portalets and shower rooms in the billeting schools.
 15. Participants will be provided with shuttle services to/from the billeting schools to the Marikina Convention Center and Marikina Sports Complex to attend Convergence's events.
 16. Participants must be at their billeting schools before the set time for lights off. Should there be a need to go outside the billeting schools, they must always be accompanied by their chaperones. Other specific guidelines with respect to the billeting shall be presented during the Orientation on July 29.

17. As stipulated in DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 titled, *“Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities”*, all participants are required to have their own travel insurance covering inclusive dates of travel from the point of departure to Marikina City, and back, either group or individual, before proceeding to the LearnCon PH 2023.
18. All participants are hereby advised to attend the **General Orientation with the Official Participants (Chaperones) of Learners’ Convergence PH 2023 on 24 July 2023, at 10:00 a.m. via MS Teams.** You may click the link to join the meeting, https://bit.ly/LearnConPH2023_General-Orientation. Please enter the meeting room fifteen (15) minutes before the actual orientation.
