**CONFERENCE ON THE CONDUCT OF ADVOCACY CAMPAIGN FOR

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**
This Region

1. To provide an inclusive education that will focus on the needs of diverse Filipino learners specifically the Muslim Out-of-School Youth and Adult (MOSYA) learners, this Office will conduct a **Conference on the Conduct of Advocacy Campaign for Technical Vocational and Livelihood in Arabic Language and Islam Values Education (ALIVE)** on January 4-5, 2018. The venue will be announced on a separate memorandum.
2. The activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Promote the integration of TVL in ALIVE to MOSYA learners and stakeholders; and

 - b. Transportation and other incidental expenses (including accommodation expenses in cases when the participant arrives earlier/leaves later than the specified official schedule of the activity due to the availability of trips to and from the venue) of the participants shall be

charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.

4. Food, accommodation, supplies, and materials shall be charged to the Madrasah Education Program Support Fund.
