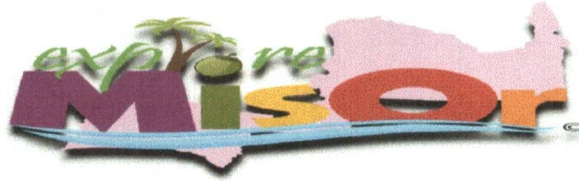

Dear Dr. Dela Peña;

Greetings!

Recently the Provincial Health Office, Misamis Oriental conducted the roll -out training for Peer Support Group for the Youth Oversight Committees for the three (3) pilot sites of Claveria, Villanueva and Tagoloan. After which, each municipality discussed the next steps to conduct the Peer Facilitators training for three (3) half days in order to capacitate the peers on what to do when there is a need to support the teens aged 12 to 24 years old in time of mental crisis.

The Peer Support Group Oversight Committee shall determine the ideal number of peer facilitators, provided that the number does not exceed the ideal ratio of 1 accredited peer facilitator for every 10 members in a support group. In the transitory period where the number of accredited peer facilitators does not meet the demand of number of members in peer support groups, qualified volunteer peer facilitators shall be guided by any member of the Peer Support Group Oversight Committee or by accredited peer facilitators.

In the implementation of the peer support program, the principle of voluntarism shall be consistently promoted and observed while recognizing the need for developing and institutionalizing a support system for peer facilitators.

In this regard, we would like to ask your kind- hearted support to allow the Peer Oversight Committee members to conduct a screening and selection of Senior High Schools students in particular government and private schools of Claveria, Villanueva and Tagoloan to become the Peer Facilitators. And in addition to our request, we would also like to allow the Designate Guidance Councilors' of the three (3) pilot sites to attend the brief orientation on the last half day of the said days of training.

Likewise, Peer Support Group for the Youth Oversight Committee members will ensure that the select Senior High School students shall passed the minimum qualifications observed in the selection of peer facilitators standards. And these are the schedules for the selection and screening to

wit; 1) Claveria – January 17, 2022; 2) Villanueva - January 18, 2022; 3) Tagoloan – January 19, 2022. All Dep Ed Nurses of the three (3) pilot sites are members of the Peer Oversight Committee.

We fervently hope that this capacity building for the peer facilitators will help the Mental Health Program thru group sessions about mental issues, problems in the family and other concerns that would benefit the peer's mental health in this Covid 19 pandemic times.

As partners for the upliftment for health and social services of our constituents in Misamis Oriental, we look forward for your positive response on this matter.
