REITERATION OF STRONG SUPPORT FOR PEDIATRIC VACCINATION AGAINST COVID – 19 (AGES 5 -11) IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/ District In-charge
Elementary and Secondary Principals
Teaching and Non-teaching Personnel
All Others Concerned

1. **DepEd Task Force COVID – 19 (DFTC) Memorandum No. 606 approved by the Secretary**, dated February 4, 2022, all teaching and non-teaching personnel shall initiate and support the vaccination of learners ages 5 – 11 years old through information dissemination and demand generation in all public schools in coordination with Local Government Units and the Department of Health.
2. A meeting with Department of Health Region X conducted last February 11, 2022, the following were asked from DepEd as partner agency:
 - a. Teachers are required to submit a master list of learners aged 5-11 years old per grade level per section per school on/or before February 16, 2022. Template will be provided thru the district/ school nurse.
 - b. Each school will set up a vaccination site to inoculate their learners with air conditioned room as vaccination area. If no airconditioned room is available, air conditioned vehicle can be used instead.
 - c. Teachers are requested to assist during the vaccination schedule of their respective students while health personnel are requested to assist in the post vaccination monitoring of vital signs, reporting and recording.
 - d. A monthly report on vaccination coverage and activities will be required.
3. Vaccination in schools will start on February 21, 2022, until May 2022 for 1st dose. Second dose will be in March 2022 to June 2022. An interval of 3 weeks from the 1st to 2nd dose is required. Pfizer vaccine will be used.
