

**Action Requested:** For information, support and participation

1. The 2022 National Women’s Month Celebration (NWMC) in March endeavors to highlight the gains achieved for women and girls, assess actions towards gender equality and look forward to steps that must be taken to ensure progress in empowering women. With the country still reeling from the COVID-19 pandemic, studies and data show that the health crisis stalled movements towards gender equality, worsening inequalities, further exposing gender gaps, and exacerbating vulnerabilities in social and political, and economic aspects.
2. The NWMC theme for 2017-2022 is “*WE Make CHANGE Work for Women*” with this year’s sub-theme “*Agenda ng Kababaihan, Tungo sa Kaunlaran,*” highlights the empowerment of women as active contributors to and claimholders of development. It will be a celebration of women exercising their choices, taking chances to make their voices heard, and benefitting from and trailblazing changes. Likewise, it is a celebration of Filipino women’s power to take the narrative, raise priority issues that matter to them, and call for concrete actions.



**2022 NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION (NWMC)  
RDC-X Regional Gender and Development Committee (RGADC) Outreach Program  
8 March 2022 @ 8:00am-12:00nn**

For the month of March, the entire nation is celebrating National Women's Month<sup>1</sup> through the conduct of various activities aligned with the 2017-2022 theme: "We Make Change Work for Women."

On 8 March 2022, International Women's Day,<sup>2</sup> the entire world celebrates this significant day with the theme "Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow."<sup>3</sup> The theme recognizes the role and contribution of women and girls as change leaders to build a more sustainable future for all."

The gendered effects when coupled with the COVID-19 crisis bring in the vivid picture of the most vulnerable. Poor communities further plunge into food and livelihood insecurity due to closure of businesses and unemployment, limited mobility, increasing risks to diseases and rising medical expenses.

While women and girls are recognized as more vulnerable than men, they are also involved in sustainability efforts in the world including the Philippines. In Region X , there are programs and projects of regional agencies and local government units that build the leadership capacities of women and/or open opportunities for girls to develop their potentials in becoming change-makers.

The RDC-X RGADC, with the support of its members, will also extend its assistance to women and girls in selected shelters/centers in Cagayan de Oro City through an outreach program during the International Women's Day Celebration. The proposed beneficiaries are as follows:

- **Home Care for Girls**

- This center is managed by the City Social Welfare and Development (CSWD), LGU of Cagayan de Oro City, located at Macanhan, Carmen, CDOC. It aims to provide temporary shelter and alternative parental care and protection to the *Dependent, Physically & Sexually Abused and Neglected* children, in a safe and home-like environment. It also provides different programs and services to the in-house children, such as: Home Life Services; Social Services; Educational Services (Formal & Non-formal Education); Livelihood and Productivity Skills Training; Socio Cultural and Recreational Activities; and Religious/Spiritual Services.
- Number of Clients: **19 clients (7 to 17 years old)**

- **Balay Paglaum**

- This center is managed by the City Social Welfare and Development (CSWD) of Cagayan de Oro, located at Macanhan, Carmen, CDOC. It aims to provide temporary shelter and protection, relief, and appropriate crisis intervention to the children in conflict with the law; children in special situation; and women who were

victims of gender-based violence from further harm or hazardous/high risk situations, thereby facilitating their healing and recovery for their eventual reintegration to families and communities through various center-based services and interventions.

- Number of Clients: **22 clients (5 mothers with their children, from 1 month to 6 years old)**

- **Home for Girls**

- This center is managed by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Region X located at Masterson Avenue, Lumbia Road, Upper Carmen, CDOC. It is primarily a residential treatment facility for girl children aged 7 to age below 18 years old who have been removed from their families due to sexual abuse or exploitation, and have been taken custody by the Center. Children clients of the Home are referred by the Police, Government and Non-Government Organizations, Local Government Units, family of the victims or concerned citizens.

- Number of Clients: **35 clients (4 mos. to 17 years old)**

- **CDOCJ Female Dormitory**

- Cagayan de Oro City Jail - Female Dormitory is managed by BJMP-X located at F. Delima St., Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City and currently serves **240 detainees.**

A validation and needs assessment of the beneficiaries will be conducted by the assigned focal persons from NEDA-X/PCW-NMFO to determine the appropriate interventions to be provided by the RGADC-X members. The said focal persons will directly coordinate with the all assigned RGADC-X members within February 2022 on the type of assistance/items to be provided to the beneficiaries.

There should be a written, photo and video documentation of each outreach site in order to produce a short article, social media story that would capture the essence and highlight of the activity.

**MECHANICS:**

- Open to all RGADC-X member LGUs, RLAs, academe and private sector (except the Secretariat).
- One (1) team per office composed of three (3) representatives (combination of male and female).
- Participating teams are requested to register through this link <https://bit.ly/RGADC-quiz-reg> on or before **25 March 2022**.
- Quiz bee questions will mainly cover general Gender and Development topics with three (3) category levels: Easy, Average, and Difficult.
- During the quiz bee:
  - Participants should have stable internet connection
  - Each team will register only one gadget in the zoom link with the name of the office they represent. Example: NEDA-X
  - Cameras are required to be turned-on during the entire duration of the quiz bee
- Orientation on the detailed mechanics of the quiz bee will be provided to the participating teams on 31 March 2021, one hour before the start of the quiz bee proper.
- Awarding of winners will be during the 31 March 2021 culminating activity at 1:30 p.m. Top 5 teams will receive a trophy each, and medals will also be given to the representatives/ contestants. Certificates of Participation will be given to all participants.
- The Secretariat will administer the quiz bee and will invite non-participating RGADC-X members as monitors to ensure objectivity of its conduct.

## Objective:

To showcase and honor the women in the agency/organization, their various roles/contributions in the performance of the agency's mandate towards the achievement of goals and objectives, as well as, their hopes and aspirations for change.

## Mechanics:

1. The contest is open to all Region X LGU/RLA/NGA/SUC/NGO/PO.
2. Each entry must be an original work of the agency/organization with only 1 entry per agency/organization is allowed.
3. There will be no limit on the number of participants in the video.
4. The video entry shall espouse the 2017-2022 NWMC Theme : "We make Change Work for Women" with focus on women in the agency/organization, their various roles/contributions in the performance of the agency's mandate towards the achievement of goals and objectives, as well as, their hopes and aspirations for change.
5. Each agency must submit their registration form through this link <https://bit.ly/RGADC-video-reg> together with their video link (participants shall upload their video through an online drive).
6. The video must run for at least 1 minute but not more than 3 minutes (including title screen and credits at the end of the video).
7. Video resolution should at least be 720p (1280x720), 25fps frame rate.
8. Videos should not :
  - Violate a person's right, including but not limited to intellectual property rights and privacy;
  - Contain offensive, inappropriate, disparaging remarks or content which could adversely affect the name, reputation or goodwill of the agency nor of any person/s involved in the entry.
9. An ENTRY NUMBER shall be assigned upon submission.
10. It is the sole responsibility of the agency/organization to secure consent from concerned parties if the video contains material or element that is not the participant's property or if any person appears in the video. Under no circumstances shall the RDC-X RGADC be held liable.
11. The participating agency/organization authorizes the RDC-X RGADC to post the video entry in the RDC-X RGADC fb page.
12. Once the official entries are uploaded to the RDC-X RGADC fb page, public voting will start. Overall social media engagement shall be based on the total number of Facebook likes/reactions/shares.
13. The Board of Judges shall be composed of representatives from the following agencies/ organizations: NEDA-X, PCW-NMFO, BIR RR16, DAWN and RIMCU. In such case, these agencies are barred from joining the contest. The decision of the judges is final. No appeal is allowed.
14. Deadline for submission of entries will be on **11 March 2022** at 5:00 p.m.

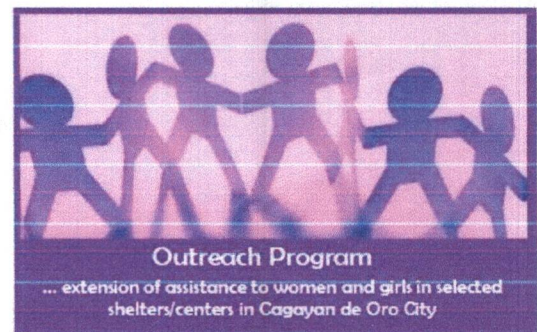
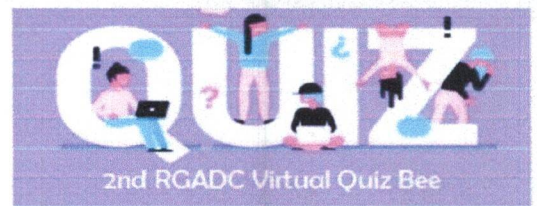
