**INTENSIVE ATHLETIC TRAINING OF QUALIFIED ATHLETES
IN PREPARATION AND PARTICIPATION TO THE 2023 NMRAA MEET**

1. In preparation and participation to the 2023 Northern Mindanao Regional Athletic Association (NMRAA) Meet, an Athletic Intensive Training will be conducted by this Office on the following schedule specified herein:

2-week Live-In Athletic Intensive Training	March 23 – April 05, 2023	• In-School for All Sports Events • Claveria CS/USTP Claveria (<i>for Athletics</i>)

2. The school-based intensive athletic training aims to:

- Heighten the competence level of the learner-athletes in their respective chosen sports discipline;
- Improve the overall performance in the Little League Philippines Series – Mindanao Regionals by sustaining or topping the routine level;
- Familiarize the Little League Competition Rules enforced by the delegation;
- Strengthen teamwork and camaraderie among team members and the entire delegation in general.

3. All other athlete-players who were selected from other districts may have their intensive training in their own school during the first two weeks. The school sports coordinator and coaches are directed to supervise their athlete's training activity.

4. To observe time-on-task pursuant to DepEd Order No.9, s.2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*, all Schools Heads are directed to take charge and monitor the classes and that curriculum and instructional delivery shall continue. Teaching personnel who are actively involved in the Athletic Intensive Training as Coach/Trainer shall provide instructional activities and materials to achieve the lesson of the day.

Further, it is encouraged that schools which are affected by this activity shall implement flexible learning modality as highlighted by Vice-President and Secretary Sara Duterte during her 2023 Basic Education Report. Teacher-Coaches and athlete's teacher concerned are advised to prepare the learning modules to be used by the learner-athletes during the entire training.
6. In compliance with DepEd OrderNo.39, s.2022 entitled *Health and Safety Protocols in the Light of the COVID-19 Pandemic*, the COVID-19 risk mitigating measures shall be observed during the conduct of the Intensive Athletic Training.
7. Travel, Meals and snacks of all enlisted athletes, coaches, trainers, chaperons and coaching staff shall be charged to Municipal SEF/Local Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
