Relative to OUA Memorandum 00-0322-0196 dated 22 March 2022, *Monitoring of DepEd Computerization Program (DCP)*, the Technology Infrastructure Division of the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS-TID) introduced the DCP Online Monitoring Tool to encourage faster submission of feedback and related input from recipient and candidate recipient schools.
