**SUBJECT:** ORIENTATION – WORKSHOP ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL –BASED  
FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) FOR SY 2017 -2018 ON AUGUST 7,8 AND 9, 2017  
VENUE TBA

- I. In consonance with DepED ORDER No. \_\_, s. 2017 entitled **Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of School - Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for SY 2017-2022**, School - Based Feeding Program should be implemented to address undernutrition among public school children.
- II. The program aims to improve the Nutritional Status of the beneficiaries by at least **70%** at the end of the **120 feeding days** and to increase classroom attendance by **85% to 100%**. It also aims to improve children's health and nutrition values and behaviour.
- III. Target beneficiaries are the severely wasted and wasted pupils based on the Baseline Nutritional Status for the school year 2017 -2018.
- IV. A budget of **P18.00** (P16.00 for food and P2.00 for operational expenses) is allotted per beneficiary for **120 feeding days**.
- V. All beneficiaries should be dewormed prior to feeding.

- VI. School Heads should monitor the daily implementation of the feeding activities while the Division TWG should monitor the school compliance with guidelines, procurement process, health and nutrition assessment, and the conduct of other complementary activities.
- VII. Feeding should start not later than **August 15, 2017** to end up **February 27, 2018**.
- VIII. At the end of the program all implementing schools are required to submit Program Terminal Report to the head of the School Division Technical Working Group. (SDTWG).
- IX. Participants of this Orientation –Workshop are **School Heads and the Feeding Teachers** of schools with wasted and severely wasted pupils numbering from 1 and more based on the Baseline Nutritional Status for SY 2017 – 2018.
- X. Venue and food shall be charged to Division MOOE while travelling expenses and per diem shall be charged to the local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
- XI. Attached is the list of SBFP recipient schools for SY 2017 – 2018.
