
- 1. In line with the implementation of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Task Force shall conduct the National Training of Trainers (NTOT) on the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) on March 18-27, 2019 at Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The Regional Mass Training of ALS Teachers (MTOT) on ALS K to 12 BEC in coordination with Regional Offices' ALS Training Committee (CLMD Chief, Regional OuAD, Regional ALS Focal Person, and all Regional ALS Core of Trainers), shall be conducted within the months of April and May 2019.
- 3. The NTOT aims to build the capacity of trainers to conduct the MTOT. The MTOT intends to provide ALS teachers with concrete understanding of the ALS K to 12 BEC framework. learning standards and competencies, pedagogy/andragogy, session plans and assessment.
- 4. The participants in the NTOT are the NEAP and DepEd-ALS trained teacher-trainers, Education Program Specialist II for ALS (EPSA) and Regional and Division ALS Supervisors/Focal Persons, selected and recommended by their respective Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs), and endorsed by the Regional Directors (RDs) through the Regional ALS Focal Persons based on the criteria found in Enclosure No. 1. Only those who completed the NTOT shall serve as MTOT trainers.

- 5. Training costs, which cover board and lodging, travel expenses of the management staff, trainers, teachers and resource persons, honoraria of resource speakers, supplies and materials, and other incidental expenses shall be charged to the 2018 Continuing ALS Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The travel expenses of the participants in all activities covered in this Memorandum will be downloaded directly to the SDOs except for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) where participants' transportation allowance shall be directly downloaded to the Regional Office of BARMM and shall be paid in full upon submission of the travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. The participants in the Regional MTOT are permanent or regular ALS teachers (Mobile Teachers and District ALS Coordinators) in all ALS school-based and community-based learning centers (CLC) nationwide. Training funds for the conduct of MTOT will be downloaded to the ROs through the Support to Operations (STO) for ALS.
- 7. In preparation for the NTOT and MTOT, the following sub-activities will be conducted:
