INTENSIVE MONITORING IN PREPARATION FOR THE 100-PERCENT IN-PERSON CLASSES

1. In consonance with the Regional Memorandum No. 587, s. 2022, this Office directs the CID Chief, Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisors, Public Schools Districts In-charge, and School Heads to conduct an Intensive Monitoring in Preparation for the 100 Percent In-Person Classes for the whole month of October.
2. The monitoring is aimed at checking of the following:
 - a. readiness of learners,
 - b. learning loss intervention and
 - c. Learning Continuity and Recovery Plan (LRCP) implementation.
3. Travel and other expenses in conducting the activity shall be charged to Division Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Attached is the Education Program Supervisors' Rotational Monitoring Assignment which will take effect on October 11, 2022. For the PSDSs and PSDICs, they will work in tandem with the EPS in their respective districts.
