**RAPID ASSESSMENT OF DAMAGES REPORT (RADaR)
REGISTRATION by the SCHOOL HEAD**

TO: ALL School Heads
District DRRM Technical Members (PDO I / AO II)
All Others Concerned

1. One of the main components of the Comprehensive School Safety Project of the Department of Education is the enhanced Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADaR) web and mobile application that aims to quickly report impacts of different natural hazards in the schools in terms of infrastructure damages, personnel casualties, classrooms used as evacuation centers, temporary learning spaces needed, as well as non-infrastructure damages such as furniture, learning resources, and computer sets.
2. In order to fully utilize the RADaR features, **ALL SCHOOL HEADS** are automatically the School Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordinators (SDRRMC) and are hereby instructed to complete self-registration process on or before **February 29, 2024** through this link: **<https://drrmis.deped.gov.ph>**.
3. Previous registration to the RADaR by the teaching personnel are already deleted to start the year with a clean slate and in response to the recent issuance of DepEd Order no. 2, s.2024, also known as the DepEd Order on the immediate removal of administrative tasks of public school teachers.
4. Successful self-registration to the RADaR by the School Head is also the fulfillment their mandate to be in Authority, Responsible, and Accountable in managing all school affairs as stated in the Republic Act No. 9155, also known as the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001.



5. The District DRRM Technical Member shall ensure that all School Heads in their area of responsibility have successfully registered by using this monitoring tool, **https://bit.ly/RADaR_registration_monitoring_tool**.
