Failure to prepare the aforementioned will warrant non-participation to the said activity.
5. Travelling and other incidental expenses shall be charged against SSG Funds/School MOOE Funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

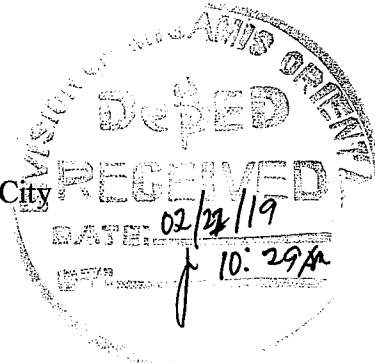
