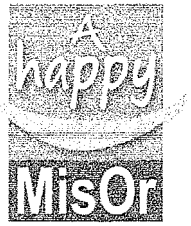

The Rover Leadership Training aims to strengthen advance quality community-based Scouting program that gives young people the opportunity to develop their skills and acquire competences necessary to survive in an increasingly complex and challenging world.

Activities during the Rover Leadership Training are uniquely designed to develop participants' full potentials in serving the community, to improve skills in disaster management at the School and community level, and to address the existing social malady caused by drugs and vices.



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A training fee of Four Hundred Fifty Pesos (P450.00) will be collected from each participant to cover the cost of their registration to the BSP which will entitles them coverage of one year of its financial assistance program, scout neckerchief and slide, certificate and other operational expenses.

In activities of this nature, participants must bring their own food provisions, sleeping bags, extra clothes and personal toilet kit enough to last for the duration of the training. However, meals are available at the host school canteen and food stalls at participant's costs.

Training expenses may be charged to Local Funds or Local School Board Funds/Other Funds subject to the approval of the Local Chief Executive and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations or personal funds.

In consideration of the DepEd Policy on "No disruption of Classes", the Training will commence on a Friday at 6:00 PM and will end on a Sunday at 12:00 noon.

In addition, we would like to request that all adult leaders who will serve as Resource Speakers, Facilitators, Training Staff, Support Staff, Scout Chaperon will be given due service credits pursuant to the guidelines stipulated in the above-cited DepEd Order.

As such, we adhere to maintaining standards, guarding the issuance of commissions in accordance with the law and established regulations as stipulated in the Standard Local Council Constitution and Bylaws.
