REGIONAL CONVERGENCE OF EDUCATIONAL LEADERS
ON CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. The global COVID-19 pandemic and its consequences have exacerbated the already-existing crisis in education. Recognizing the need for continuous concerted efforts toward addressing this crisis vis-à-vis DepEd NorMin's implementation of the Learning Recovery and Continuity Plan (LRCP) across all levels of governance, this Office will spearhead a hybrid **Regional Convergence of Educational Leaders on Curriculum and Instruction** at the Audio-Visual Center (AVC) of DepEd RO-X, Zone 1, Upper Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, on November 24-25.

2. Bannering the theme "Revisiting Curriculum and Instruction in Light of the Key issues, Trends, and Strategies for Sustainable Development in a Post-Pandemic Era in the Region," this convergence aims to identify the main issues, strategies, and innovations in understanding the curriculum as a driver toward quality learning opportunities, processes, and outcomes for all learners and reorient educators to education recovery toward sustainable development amidst emergencies in education.

3. Since this convergence will be conducted through a hybrid learning modality, the onsite participants shall include the regional director, assistant regional director, schools division superintendents, assistant schools division superintendents, CID and SGOD chiefs, and RO-X Functional Division chiefs. Meanwhile, the RO and SDO education program supervisors and public schools division supervisors shall join virtually through a Zoom link, which will be given a day before the activity.

5. Traveling and accommodation expenses for onsite participants shall be charged to local funds while snacks and lunch shall be charged to the Regional Office funds, subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
