In consonance with Republic Act 7079 otherwise known as "Campus Journalism Act of 1991", the Division of Misamis Oriental will conduct a Journalism Enhancement Training for the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) Qualifiers on December 5-7, 2019 at Jasaan National High School.

The Three-Day Training is expected to enhance the coaching skills of the school paper advisers and somehow improve the journalistic predilections of the campus journalists who are qualified to participate in the National Schools Press Conference. Some intensive activities will be executed in the evening.

All participants of the said training are advised to stay at the venue for three days and bring the indispensable paraphernalia for the different journalistic events.

Speakers' traveling expenses, food, accommodation and honoraria shall be charged to Division Funds. NSPC qualifiers' (coaches and campus journalists) travel, food and other expenses are chargeable against school downloaded funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing, rules and regulations.

The training aims to:

- a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
- b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
- c. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students who has the passion in journalistic activities;
- d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
- e. enhance journalistic competence of the NSPC qualifiers cum improve the journalistic coaching skills of the school paper advisers.
