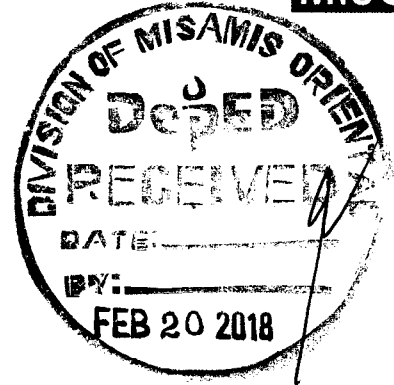

SUBJECT : 1ST A HAPPY MISOR JUNIOR LEADERS ADVANCEMENT CAMP


1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 74, s. 2012 re: Revitalizing Scouting Movement in the entire country, we are pleased to announce the conduct of the 1st A Happy MisOr Junior Leaders Advancement Camp on April 12-15, 2018 at the DepEd Park, Civolleg, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental with the theme: "Scouts: Building a Happy MisOr".
2. The Advancement Camp aims to provide meaningful activities and avenue to showcase the knowledge and skills of Scouts in Scouting and leadership, enabling them to become a well-rounded individual, self-reliant and useful citizen of the country. It offers participating Scouts the opportunity to experience the outdoor life, learn new skills and values, enhance camp craft abilities, gain advancement requirements and engage fellow Scouts in doing significant contributions to make MisOr Happy.
3. The qualifications for participation are as follows:
 - a. Currently registered to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines as Boy Scout, Senior Scout, Rover Scout and IH/Unit Leader/Outfit Advisor/Scout Volunteer;
 - b. Physically fit as certified by a physician;
 - c. Have good leadership potentials;
 - d. Have camping gears and equipment; and,
 - e. Have parent's permit.
4. A registration fee of FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (PhP 450.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for souvenir item/s, certificate, ID, Administrative cost, Jamboree materials and other operational expenses.
5. The following registration deadlines shall be strictly enforced to determine the actual number of participants and to facilitate the purchase of event souvenirs and materials:


Application for Participation	-	February 22, 2018
Confirmation of Participation	-	March 23, 2018
Remittance of Participation full Payment	-	April 6, 2018


6. Considering the nature of the activity, contingents of each Scouting district/institution must provide their own food and other basic requirements that will be sufficient throughout the whole duration of the Camp. Wet and Dry Markets will be available at the Jamboree Site in order to ensure availability of food supplies at reasonable price.
7. Jamboree expenses may be charged to Local Funds or Local School Board Funds/Other funds subject to the approval of the Local Chief Executive and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations or personal funds.
8. Adult Leaders who will serve as Resource Speakers, Facilitators, Camp Staff, Support Staff, Scout Chaperon will be given due service credits subject to the guidelines as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.
9. District Scouting Committees are encouraged to create respective Camp Committee and promote the Camp in all schools to ensure maximum participation.
