Good	Classroom (Kindergarten)	DepEd budget	refers to a building or room funded by the DepEd National Budget whether implemented by DepEd or DPWH. (e.g. Basic Education Facilities Fund, Regular School Building Program, Public-Private Partnership School Infrastructure Program)
Needs Minor Repair	Classroom (SPED)	DepEd with counterpart funds	refers to a building or room constructed using DepEd funds with counterpart of at least 10% from other sources.
Needs Major Repair	Classroom (Elementary)	LGU / SEF	refers to a building or room funded from the Special Education Fund (SEF) and the budgets of Local Government Units (LGU): provincial, municipal or barangay units.
Condemned	Classroom (Secondary)	PTA-funded	refers to a building or room funded by the Parents-Teachers Association (PTA).
	Audio-Visual Room	Congress	refers to a building or room funded from the initiatives from members of the House of Representatives and the Senate of the Philippines.
	Canteen	Foreign funds / donors	refers to a building or room funded from foreign-assisted projects and bilateral agreements with donor countries.
