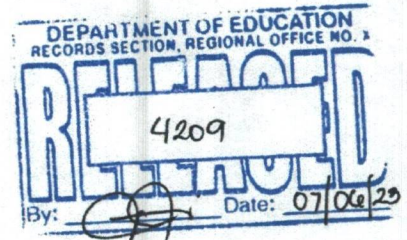

TEACHERS' CONGRESS 2023

The CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION – Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) will hold its **2023 Teachers' Congress** via online and in-person at Newtown Plaza Convention Center, Baguio City, on **July 26-27**.

The training is designed for teaching and nonteaching staff in public and private schools and other interested participants.

The training fee for virtual participation is three thousand two hundred pesos (P3,200.00) while the in-person engagement is five thousand pesos (P5,000.00).

As such, the interested personnel shall file a formal leave of absence, if applicable, and shoulder the registration fees and travel/incidental expenses, if any. Further, their participation shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith*, Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 (Policy on Contributions), DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 (Policy on Off-Campus Activities), and the DOH-prescribed health and safety standards.
