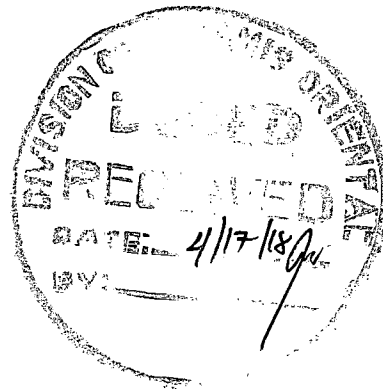

Greetings!

In its quest to stop human trafficking, BALAOD Mindanaw under Porticus funded project has continuously intensified its campaign through information, education and communication (IEC), conducting caravan to national high schools, assisting schools in the creation of their internal mechanisms and discussing with LGU for local policies on child protection for about three years now.

It started with seven (7) schools in Cagayan de Oro City in 2015 and additional of nine (9) schools in 2016 covering even the municipalities of Villanueva and Tagoloan and the city of El Salvador. To date about 100 IEC caravans had been accomplished participated in by more than 5000 participants which include students, teachers, parents and other partners. Workshops on the creation of internal mechanisms have been conducted with all the 16 schools. Two schools have completed their mechanisms and plans and have submitted approved resolutions institutionalizing anti-human trafficking activities and reporting mechanisms in their school. Follow-ups, visits and discussions with the other schools are being pursued with vigor as well as the lobbying with LGUs for the policies.

The advent of the campaign has brought BALAOD Mindanaw at the forefront of anti-human trafficking engagements not only in the city but also in nearby municipalities. Because of this, we are always grateful for your support being an active partner in this endeavor.

As the project is about to end, we create a venue for all the schools to meet one more time and share accomplishment reports and updates at the same time have a participatory evaluation on the effective ways to sustain the educational awareness campaign against human trafficking towards the protection of children. The activity will also serve as a get together of all our partners and share experiences and lessons learned during the three-year journey of the project.
