1. The Sangguniang Panlalawigan, through the Committee on Education, Culture and the Arts and in partnership with the Department of Education, invites all student-leaders and teacher-advisers of the Supreme Student Government and other school-based co-curricular clubs and organizations to attend the 5th A Happy MisOr Student Leadership Training on July 27-29, 2018 at the University of Science and Technology of Southern Philippines in Claveria, Misamis Oriental.

2. With the theme, "Rethinking Leadership in the Age of Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity, and Ambiguity", this student leadership training hopes to place in context and situate the role of student leadership as the world becomes more and more volatile, uncertain, complex and ambiguous. 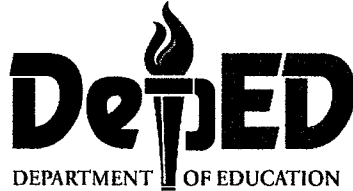

TRAINING GUIDELINES

A. ONLINE REGISTRATION

1. Online registration duration will only be until July 25, 2018.
2. Interested participants are encouraged to register online thru a link posted on the “5th A Happy MisOr Student Leadership Training” Facebook page or on any Facebook account or page of Vice Governor Joey G. Pelaez and Provincial Board Member Jigjag G. Pelaez.
3. Two links shall be provided; the first link is the “School Registration” which shall be accomplished by the Teacher-Adviser. Only one entry for the school registration will be considered valid and official. The second link is the “Personal Data Sheet” (PDS) to be filled-up by each student-participant and the teacher-adviser.
4. In order to access the links, one must have existing Google Account (Gmail). One Google account can register multiple entries for the Personal Data Sheet link.
5. Once the School Registration and Personal Data Sheets have been submitted, an email of confirmation of the official registration will be sent together with the Identification Numbers for the participants.
6. Kindly printout a copy of the confirmation email and present it to the Secretariat upon arrival and registration in the venue.

8. For those unable to register online thru the links, kindly accomplish the attached Registration Form and Personal Data Sheet, and email them thru ovg.eventsteam2017@gmail.com with the subject "5th SLT Registration" on or before July 25, 2018.
9. Those who are unable to register online thru the links or email, kindly secure three (3) copies of the Registration Form and the Personal Data Sheet. Fill them up and submit to the Secretariat together with the PDS of each student-participant during the registration at the venue.

B. SCHOOL-DELEGATION

1. Each participating school shall be composed of at least five (5) student-leaders from the Junior High School and ten (10) student-leaders from the Senior High School, excluding the teacher-advisers.
2. Schools with no Senior High School can send at least fifteen (15) student-leaders from the Junior High School.

C. ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

1. Participating student-leaders with their respective teacher-advisers are expected to arrive at the training venue at 7:00 AM or earlier on July 27, 2018. Registration duration is from 7:00AM to 9:00AM only.
2. Upon arrival, please proceed to the holding area at the covered court of the USTP-Claveria, fronting the cafeteria for the registration.
3. Only teacher-advisers, assisted by one (1) student-participant per school delegation, are allowed to transact with the Secretariat to avoid overcrowding.
4. Pre-registered schools must directly proceed to the "Verification Counter for Pre-Registered delegates" to present the email confirmation.
5. Walk-in participants with filled-up Registration Form (3 copies) and complete Personal Data Sheets must proceed to the "Verification Counter for Walk-Ins". Otherwise, secure the forms from the Secretariat.
6. After processing with the Verification Counter, kindly proceed to the Distribution Counter for the IDs and Training Kits.
7. Proceed to the Billeting Counter for the quarter/room assignments. Student-volunteers from USTP-Claveria Campus will be the official facilitators for the billeting process.
8. USTP-Claveria Campus will still hold classes on 27 July 2018. In effect, some billeting areas may not yet be available at the time of the registration. The Secretariat will implement measures to protect belongings of school-delegations.
9. Online-registered contestants for the Search for Mr. and Ms. Student Leader Personality 2018 must confirm the registration at the appropriate counter during the Registration on 27 July 2018.

10. Online-registered contestants for the Student-Leaders Got Talent must confirm the registration at the appropriate counter during the Registration on 27 July 2018.

D. PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES

1. The Opening Ceremony for the 5th A Happy MisOr Student Leadership Training will be held at the USTP-Claveria Auditorium on July 27, 2018 at 10:00AM.
2. The 1st Plenary Session following the Opening Ceremony will start at 1:00 PM. Participants are expected to be at the Auditorium ten (10) minutes before the schedule.
3. Break-out sessions for teacher-advisers will be held in a separate venue. The time and venue will be announced during the training.
4. Everyone is expected to actively participate in all the activities.
5. The Closing Program for the training will be held at the Auditorium on July 29, 2018 at 8:00AM. The distribution of certificates will follow.
6. Please see attached Schedule of Activities.

E. SEARCH FOR MR. AND MS. STUDENT LEADER PERSONALITY

1. The Search for Mr. and Ms. Student Leader Personality 2018 is open to all male and female student-leaders participating in the 5th A Happy MisOr Student Leadership Training. It is an opportunity for the student-leaders to showcase their potentials in becoming role models for the youth. The contest aims to produce student-leaders that embody the core values of "Genuine Service with A Happy Mind and A Happy Heart."
2. To join, contestants must have the following qualifications:
 - a. Must be a bonafide student of the school being represented; and,
 - b. Hold a position in the Supreme Student Government (SSG) or School-Based Clubs or Organizations.
3. The following are the general instructions and mechanics:
 - a. **Online Registration**
 1. Student-leaders who wish to join will have to register online to be considered as official candidates. Period of registration is from **July 17 to 23, 2018**.
 2. Registration is **STRICTLY** online. However, walk-in registration at the Office of the Vice Governor within the duration dates will be considered.
 3. For each contestant, please submit the following:
 - a. Scanned and filled out official registration form;
 - b. 2 formal photos wearing school uniform **on a blue or dark-colored background [(1 head to chest level and 1 head to hip level) photos]**; and
 - c. 1 pair/couple shot (head to hip level) of the contestants.

b. Advocacy Video

1. The aspiring Student Leader Personality contestants must submit a video of herself/himself answering the question:
“If you will become Mr./Ms. Student Leader Personality, what is your advocacy and why?”
2. Length of video shall not exceed 1 minute.
3. Email the registration form, photos and video thru **ovg.eventsteam2017@gmail.com** with the subject **MMSLP 2018 - (NAME OF SCHOOL)**.

c. People’s Choice Award (Facebook)

1. Submitted photo entry of the contestants will be posted on Vice Governor Joey G. Pelaez’ Facebook page.
2. Contestants must invite friends and/or family to LIKE and SHARE their photo entry.
3. **One (1) point** is counted for every LIKE on each photo and **two (2) points** for every SHARE.
4. The tallying of likes and shares will only be based on the original post of the photo on the official Facebook page of the 5th A Happy MisOr Student Leadership Training.
5. The female and male contestants who garnered the highest count of likes, shares and judges’ scores will be awarded with the People’s Choice Award.
6. Voting period is from **July 24 until July 28, 2018 at 12 NN.**
7. Winner of the special award will be announced during the pageant night.

d. Best in Career Wear

1. The “Best in Career Wear” is another criterion for judging where student-contestants will present their future professional selves thru their career uniforms. They will introduce themselves and explain why they have chosen the type of career for their future.

4. To get the top 5 (5 males and 5 females), the average scores of the advocacy video submitted (60%) and career wear category (40%) will be computed and ranked accordingly. The top 5 candidates will proceed to the On-Stage Question Round.
5. Criteria for Judging are as follows:

F. STUDENT LEADERS GOT TALENT

Every year, one of the most-awaited features during the conduct of the A Happy MisOr Student Leadership Training is the "MisOr Student Leaders Got Talent". The activity highlights variety of talent presentations in the areas of music, dance, drama or comedy acts, and other artistic renditions among the participants proudly representing their

respective schools. For four consecutive years, the holding of the activity has been successful. Apart from delivering entertainment and a night of recreation for our student leaders, this year's conduct of the MisOr Student Leaders Got Talent demonstrates the value of camaraderie among participants in coming up with a theme-accord presentation.

1. The following are the mechanics:
 - a. Online pre-registration is required from July 17-23, 2018 only. Entries beyond the deadline will not be considered.
 - b. Interested participants must fill out the official registration form provided.
 - c. Send a videoclip of the presentation (**MAXIMUM OF 2 MINUTES**) thru ovg.eventsteam2017@gmail.com together with the filled out registration form with email subject MGT 2018 – (NAME OF SCHOOL).
 - d. For those who cannot access the internet, please contact Ms. Drita Angela Lopez thru mobile number 0936-4528860.
 - e. Take note of the following:
 - *Solo or group presentation.*
 - *STRICTLY NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION.*
 - *For group presentation, a maximum of 15 members are allowed.*
 - *Teacher-Advisers are encouraged to participate.*
 - *Candidates of the Mr. and Ms. Student Leader Personality 2018 are not allowed to join the MisOr Student Leaders Got Talent contest.*
2. Official entries for the contest will present on special time slots during the duration of the training or during the Search for Mr. and Ms. Student Leader Personality.
3. The length of performance **SHOULD NOT EXCEED 3 MINUTES**.
4. All performances must follow appropriate language, dress code and music choice. Any inappropriateness may disqualify the performer/s upon the discretion of the committee and judges.
5. The criteria for judging are as follows:

G. DISTRIBUTION OF CERTIFICATES

1. The distribution of certificates will be held after the Closing Program on July 29, 2018.
2. Teacher-advisers must present the Participant's Copy of the Registration Form when claiming the Certificate of Participation and Certificate of Appearance.

H. CATERING SERVICE

1. The University of Science and Technology of Southern Philippines – Claveria Campus will offer catering services for interested participants of the training.
2. SSG Advisers should transact with the cafeteria as regards their meal arrangement thru **Ms. Mary Joy Bendanillo** thru mobile number **0975-9460092**. All concerns regarding meals (dietary restrictions, preferences, etc.) must only be directly coordinated to them.
3. Participants who will avail of the catering services are advised to bring individual “bento” lunch boxes, utensils and cups. Styrofoam is not allowed.
4. The covered court, located just outside the cafeteria, will serve as mess hall for the participants.
5. **For those who will not avail of the catering services, USTP-Claveria will provide areas where participants can cook/prepare their meals. Using of rice cooker inside the classroom is prohibited for safety purposes.**

I. WHAT TO BRING

1. Participants of the training are required to bring the following:
 - a. Casual and event-appropriate clothes good for three (3) days. Jackets and cardigans are advised for the cold weather;
 - b. Sleeping bags, pillows, blankets and mosquito nets;
 - c. Toiletries;
 - d. First Aid kits per school;
 - e. Individual “bento” lunch boxes, utensils and cups;
 - f. Cookware;
 - g. Notebook and pen;
 - h. Drinking water;
 - i. Tents (if participants prefer to camp at identified areas in the training venue); and;
 - j. **Garbage bag.** To ensure a clean and safe environment for the participants, each school-delegation is required to bring garbage bag where trash/waste materials will be placed. USTP will identify areas where garbage bins will be placed for collection and disposal.

J. HOUSE RULES

1. Student-participants and teacher-advisers are expected to observe proper decorum and follow rules during the course of the training.
2. All participants must actively participate in all the activities prepared for the training.
3. Mobile phones and gadgets must be put to silent mode or turned-off to avoid distracting other participants or the speakers during the sessions.
4. Student-leaders must show respect to fellow participants, guests and speakers at all times.

5. Punctuality must be observed. Breaks between sessions are monitored. A countdown timer will be flashed on the projector screen. Late participants will be listed and noted. Penalty of non-issuance of certificate will apply to those participants with habitual tardiness.
6. Safety is a primary concern during the training. Participants will not be allowed to leave the auditorium and other activity areas without permission from their respective teacher-advisers.
7. Bringing of prohibited paraphernalia, lethal weapons, drugs and alcohol inside the training venue premise is strictly not allowed. Anyone caught bringing these items will automatically be barred from attending further the training.
8. Clean as you go.
9. Quiet hours will start at 10:00PM.
10. Participants shall keep their quarters clean.
11. Garbage must be properly disposed of.
12. Have a happy mind and a happy heart!
