1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 7, 1994 declaring the month of November of every year as "Filipino Values Month", the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) in this Office will conduct "Regional Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition" on November 21-22, 2016 at the National Educators' Academy of the Philippines - Region 10 (NEAP-R10), Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City.
*Nov. 21 - elementary NEAP X
Nov. 22 - secondary NEAP X*
2. The theme for the said activity is "Pagpasya At Pagkilos Nang May Pananagutan Tungo Sa Kabutihang Panlahat."
3. The competition aims to enable participants to :
 - a) provide better understanding on the importance of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) in transforming a humane society;
 - b) demonstrate commitment to support the advocacy of Esp through healthy and friendly competitions; and
 - c) enhance talents and skills of student-participants and teacher-coaches in the different contested events by promoting the real Filipino values.
4. The different events to be contested both elementary and secondary levels are **likha-awit, oratorical/extemporaneous, picture story, and documentary**. It is

6. The participants to this activity are the Division Education Program Supervisors in-charge of Edukasyon sa Paggapakatao, winning students and pupils in the different levels with their teacher-coaches, school heads of the winning schools and identified district and school coordinators in-charge of ESP.
7. Pupils/Students participants shall be given enough time to prepare for quizzes and other examinations missed in their classes during the conduct of the competition. They shall also be allowed reasonable time to comply with and submit other requirements of the different subject areas.
8. Travelling expenses, lodging, and a registration fee of Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00) each participant inclusive of one (1) meal and two (2) snacks shall be charged against school/local/MOOE/local school board funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is advised that PTA and non-government funds and other funding sources be tapped for financial assistance. Plaques, medals, certificates, cash prizes, honoraria/token of the judges/facilitators, venue rentals, tarpaulin and other incidental expenses shall be charged against Regional Office MOOE Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Each Division through the Division ESP Coordinator should bring documents duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendent certifying that their contestants are officially enrolled for SY 2016-2017.

**GUIDELINES/MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR
2016 REGIONAL EDUKASYON sa PAGPAPAKATAO (EsP) COMPETITION**

a) Likha-Awit - (OPM Songwriting Competition)

1. The Division Winner for best composer/composition will be the official entry to the competition. One song is allowed per division.
2. A student participant per division shall be accompanied by one coach.
3. The song must be written in Filipino.
4. The songwriter must write inspirational song using an adaptation of any popular music.
5. Song performance must not exceed three (3) minutes.
6. The performer may use guitar, minus one or any form of keyboard.
7. Three (3) copies of the musical lyrics will be provided and must be encoded.
8. The contestants shall bring and wear their IDs for checking and verification.
9. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placers will receive cash and personalized medals with certificates while the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.
10. The decision of judges is irrevocable and final.
11. The following are the criteria for judging:

Content/Lyrics (Relevance to the Theme)	30%
Voice Quality	30%
Interpretation/Stage Presence	25%
Dynamics/Tone/Rhythm	15%
Total	100%

b. Oratorical (For Elementary Level Only)

1. There will be one entry per division.
2. The substance should be relevant to the theme.
3. The delivery should not exceed to three (3) minutes.
4. The following are the criteria:

Content/Substance/Originality	50%
Delivery (3mins)	40%
Stage Presence/Performance	10%
5. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placers will receive cash, plaque and personalized medals with certificates while the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.

1. The delivery is within five (5) minutes.
2. The content message must be in Filipino.
3. There will be only one contest piece. The contestants must be placed in a secluded room closely guarded while waiting of their turn.
4. The coaches are not allowed to enter the room.
5. The following are the criteria:

Delivery (Diction/Pronunciation/Grammar/Originality)	40%
Stage presence(Appropriate Gesture and Personal Appearance)	20%
Content Message/Relevance to the theme	40%
Total	100%
