As part of this year's National Teachers' Day / World Teachers' Day Celebration at Ateneo de Davao University, San Jacinto St., Davao City on October 5, the Department of Education, will hold the Teachers' Got Talent (TGT) Competition.

1. The contest is open to public and private school teachers from Region XI, X, XI, XII, CARAGA and ARMM.
2. The contest is open to any type of act or performance: singing, dancing of any genre and specialist acts of any nature.
3. Only one contestant (or group) per school shall be allowed to join. If joining as a group, a maximum of ten (10) members shall be allowed.
4. The presentation should last for a maximum of five (7) minutes only including the time for the entrance and exit. Two (2) points will automatically be deducted for excess minute/s.
5. Each interested individual or groups shall submit a video recording of the presentation (using phone or digital camera or other means) in a CD with the attached registration form to the Special Events Unit (SEU) of the External Partnerships Service. The CD shall be sent via courier to:

6. The Semi-final/ elimination will be held at DepEd – SEU on September 20, 2016 at 8:00 am – onwards. The 15 finalists as determined by the TGT committee will go through the finals and will receive a call and email from the committee on September 21, 2016.
7. The TGT finals shall begin at 1:00 pm on October 5. Contestants who failed to arrive on time at the designated venue shall be disqualified. The call time is at 9:00 am at the back of Ateneo de Davao University, for the general rehearsals.
