**20<sup>th</sup> EDITION MINDANAO MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS**

**To: All PS District Supervisors  
All Elementary and Secondary School Administrators  
All District/ School Sports Coordinators**

1. The 20<sup>th</sup> Edition Mindanao Milo Little Olympics will be conducted on September 30, 2016 up to October 1 & 2, 2016 at the Gregorio A. Pelaez Sports Center, Cagayan de Oro City. The Athletic Parade and Opening Program will be on September 30, 2016 at 2: 00 p.m., assembly area at Pelaez Sports Center. The event shall be participated in by elementary and secondary pupil/student athletes from the different schools in Mindanao.

2. To avoid disruption of classes, games will be done during Saturday and Sunday, September 30, 2016, October 1 & 2, 2016. This developmental sports fest is the version of the Summer Olympic Games and is open to school – based teams comprising of male and female pupils/students in elementary and secondary levels in preparation for the upcoming higher meets. ## 2016 MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS is the Developmental version of the Summer Olympic Games and is open to school – based teams comprising of male and female pupils/students in elementary and secondary levels both public and private schools in the Philippines. Individuals or sports club are not qualified.
2. The MILO LITTLE OLYMPIC features fifteen (15) sports events:

3. Competitions are divided into two (2) levels:
  - A. 12 UNDER DIVISION FOR ELEMENTARY (Grades 1-6, ages 7-12) Cut Off Year 2004
  - B. 17 UNDER DIVISION FOR SECONDARY (Grades 7-11) provide they will meet the age cut off year 1999.
4. A school must enter in a minimum of three (3) events sports events per level in order to be accepted in the MILO Little Olympics.
5. Interested teams are required to pay a non-refundable entry fee per team entry, per sports, per level.

6. All participants are required to submit an original and photocopy of their Philippine Statistic Authority (PSA) or NSO birth certificate, photo copy of Passport, photo copy of Form 137, 3 pcs. 2x2 ID picture for athletes and one (1) empty MILO 1kg (kilogram) pack along with their accomplished and signed official registration form. (1) 2x2 picture of the coach attached to the Athletes Gallery Form.

7. All participants must seek their parent's/guardian's consent and fill out the portion in the registration form where the parent/guardian, physician and school head/team coach are required to sign. Registration form may be photocopied if necessary.

8. Individuals/teams who fail to complete the required documents on the set deadline shall automatically be disqualified by the Event Organizer.

**NOTE: REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST- SERVED BASIS. ONLY SCHOOL HEAD TEAMS WITH COMPLETE REQUIREMENTS WILL BE ACCOMMODATED. The Three (3) Teams; Basketball, Football and Volleyball is limited up to 16 teams other events as many teams will be accepted.**

**REGISTRATION OFFICES:**

- A) August 1 to 31, 2016 - All schools, coaches and sports coordinators will register at MILO sub-office, 178 Belen Jongko St., Apovel Subd., Bulua, CDOC. (see MILO streamers/flaglets)
- B) September 1 to 22, 2016 – Registration office is transferred to formerly ALS Office of DepED Region X, Pelaez Sports Center, CDOC. This date is the last day of registration, no more extension.

3:00 p.m. Opening Ceremonies @ Pelaez Sports Center, CDOC  
4:00 p.m. Final Judgment of Miss MILO 2016  
4:30 p.m. Cheer Dance Competition/Awarding of Side Events.  
6:30 p.m. Fun and Entertainment by the MILO Management.
- October 1 & 2, 2016 Actual Games in different Playing Venues.
- October 15, 2016 1:00 p.m. Closing Ceremonies will be conducted @ Limketkai Events Center, CDOC.



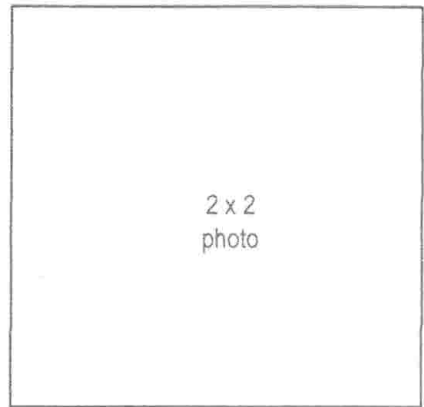
10. The Sponsor and Event Organizer will not be held responsible for any or all injuries an athlete may sustain before, during and after competition. However, in case of injuries, first-aid will be provided for the participants during the competition.
11. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the winning individuals/schools.
12. In case of typhoon or other natural calamities, the Event Organizer shall have the right to determine whether all games will be cancelled or moved to a later date with due notice to the heads of schools or authorized coaches.
13. Event Organizer reserves the right to modify any of the above rules and regulations as it deems necessary to ensure the success of the MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS.
14. The MILO Little Olympics competition is open to all bonafide pupils/students in elementary and secondary Levels of the official list of participating schools.
  - A) Elementary pupils must compete in the Elementary Division only. They must be 7 to 12 years old. The cut-off year of birth is 2004.
  - B) Secondary students must compete in the Secondary Division only. They must be 17 years old and below. The cut-off year of birth is 1999.
15. Pupil/Student Athletes found to have violated the Eligibility Rules shall be prohibited from participating in all future MILO events. The player forfeits his/her standing in the individual event, or in case of team events, his/her team forfeits all games he/she had played on.
16. The Event Organizer reserves the right to accept or deny participants, and modify any of the above rules and regulations, as it deems necessary to ensure the success of the MILO Little Olympics.
17. Knock-down system is to be applied in all sports events.
18. A non-refundable protest fee in the amount of Php 5, 000.00 shall be charged together with the written protest and the physical evidence before any action from the Tournament Manager.
