1. In consonance with DepEd Order No. 74, s. 2012 re: Revitalizing Scouting Movement in the entire country, the conduct of the **3rd A Happy MisOr Scouts Jamboree** is set on **December 1-5, 2015** at Anakan National High School, Anakan, Gingoog City with the theme: Peace and Development through Scouting.
2. The following requirements should be followed and accomplished:
 - a. Currently registered to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines as KID Scout, KAB Scout, Boy Scout, Senior Scout, Rover Scout, IH/Unit Leader/ Outfit Advisor/ Scout Volunteer;
 - b. Physically fit as certified by a government physician;
 - c. Have good leadership potentials;
 - d. Have camping gears and equipment; and
 - e. Have notarized parent's permit/consent
3. Each participant shall be charged Four Hundred Pesos (Php 400.00) to cover expenses for souvenir items, certificate, I.D., administrative cost, jamboree materials and other operational expenses.
4. Jamboree expenses may be charged to Local Funds or Local School Board Funds/Other Funds subject to the approval of the Local Chief Executive and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations or personal funds.
5. See enclosures on the Council Memorandum No. 04, s. 2015, Tentative Schedule of Activities, Pre-Registration Forms and the Guidelines and Criteria for the various activities and competitions during the Jamboree.

SUBJECT : 3rd A HAPPY MISOR SCOUTS JAMBOREE

1. In consonance with DepEd Order No. 74, s. 2012 re: Revitalizing Scouting Movement in the entire country, we are pleased to announce the conduct of the 3rd A Happy MisOr Scouts Jamboree on December 1-5, 2015 at Anakan National High School, Anakan, Gingoog City with the theme: "Peace and Development through Scouting".
2. The Jamboree aims to provide meaningful activities for the Scouts and an avenue to show their knowledge and skills in Scouting and leadership, enabling them to become a well-rounded individual and self-reliant and useful citizen of the country. It also seeks to inculcate values such as patriotism, nationalism, care for the environment and camaraderie while participating in outdoor-based non-formal education and the BSP peace initiative.
3. The 3rd A Happy MisOr Scouts Jamboree offers participating scouts the opportunity to experience the outdoor life, learn new skills, enhance their camp craft abilities, gain advancement requirements and engage fellow Scouts.
4. The Qualifications for participation are as follows:
 - a. Currently registered to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines as KID Scout, KAB Scout, Boy Scout, Senior Scout, Rover Scout, IH/Unit Leader/Outfit Advisor/Scout Volunteer;
 - b. Physically fit as certified by a physician;
 - c. Have good Leadership potentials;
 - d. Have camping gears and equipment; and,
 - e. Have parent's permit.
5. A registration of FOUR HUNDRED PESOS (PhP 400.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for souvenir item/s, certificate, ID, administrative cost, Jamboree materials and other operational expenses.

6. Considering the nature of the activity, contingents of each Scouting district/institution must provide their own food and other basic requirements that will be sufficient throughout the whole duration of the Jamboree. Wet and Dry Markets will be made available at the Jamboree Site in order to ensure availability of food supplies at reasonable price.
7. Jamboree expenses may be charged to Local Funds or Local School Board Funds/Other Funds subject to the approval of the Local Chief Executive and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations or personal funds.
8. District Scouting Committees are encouraged to create respective Jamboree Committee and promote the Jamboree in all schools to ensure maximum participation.

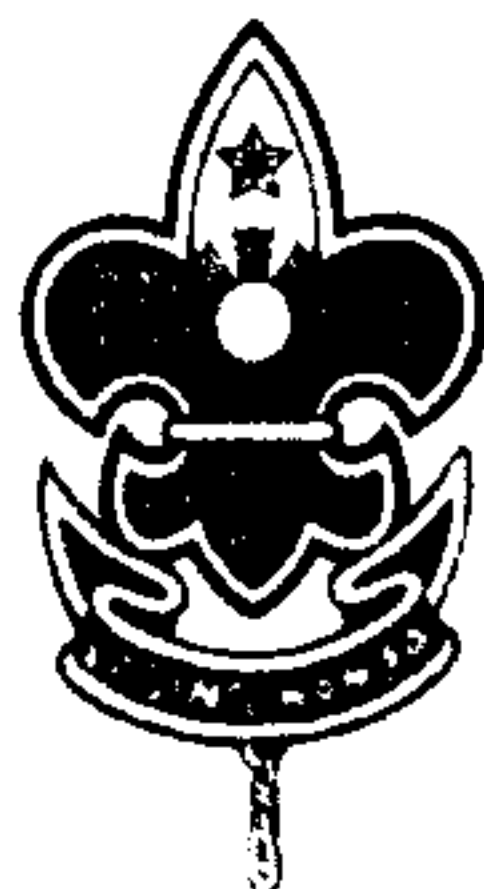

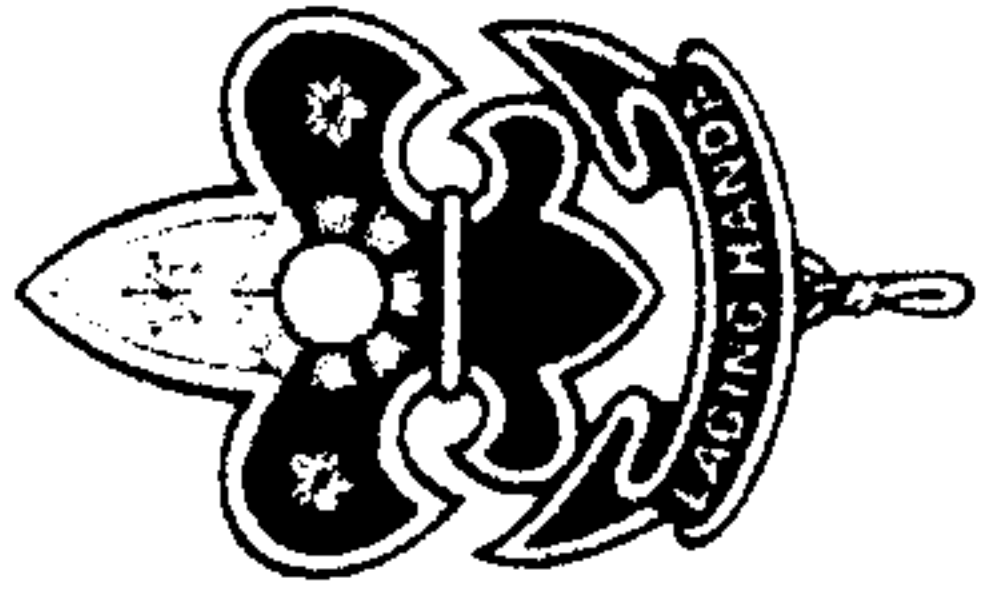

GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR FANCY DRILL COMPETITION

Mechanics and Guidelines

1. School/district must register prior to the competition
2. Participants must be duly-registered Scout Troop and or a Senior Scout Outfit composed of officially registered participant to the **3rd A HAPPY MISOR SCOUT JAMBOREE** with a **minimum number of 25** but not more than **33** Boy / Senior / Rover Scouts.
3. They must be in complete **"Type A Scout Uniform"**. Other Scout Paraphernalia such as Patrol/Crew Flags, Radian Thumbstick, Beret, Head Gear, Gloves, Lanyards, etc. are allowed and must have corresponding point credit.
4. Commands shall be made in either English or in Filipino. Silent drill, whistle command and hand gestures are allowed.
5. The participating unit shall be given a minimum of three (3) and maximum of six (6) minutes only for their performance. One long whistle blast indicates that the group has already reached the minimum time limit, while two long whistle blasts indicate that they already reached the maximum time frame.
6. One point will be deducted from the group's score if the performance exceeds the six minutes. One point will also be deducted from the group's score if their performance falls below the minimum time.
7. Fancy Drill performance with musical accompaniment from a Drum and Bugle corps and or Audio Soundtrack will be allowed.
8. There will be 2 categories: Boy Scouts Category and Senior Scouts Category. Each Category must have at least 4 participating schools or District.
9. Should there be less than 4 participating schools/district in every category, the competition will be fused to only one open category (Boy/Senior).
10. Board of Judges will be determined by the Local Jamboree Organizing Committee.
11. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Smartness & Good Order	= 25%
(Uniform, Stance, Good Grooming, Discipline)	
b. Command & Execution	= 25%
(Clarity of command, Timing and firm execution)	
Preparatory Command and Command of Execution	
c. Formation & Maneuver	= 25%
(Executes basic and advanced formation & movement)	
d. Drill Yell/Call/Beat/Cheer	= 25%
(Accompaniment of Yell, Call, Beat, Cheer during Drill)	
TOTAL	= 100%
12. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

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GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR KAB PALABAS COMPETITION

1. School/district must register prior to the competition
2. Participants must be duly-registered KAB Scouts and are officially registered as participants to the **3rd A HAPPY MISOR SCOUT JAMBOREE** with a **minimum number of 25** but not more than **33** KAB Scouts.
3. The participating group may present song, dance or any desired presentation that displays Peace and Scout's role in community building.
4. The participating group shall be given a minimum of five (5) and maximum of nine (9) minutes only for their performance. One long whistle blast indicates that the group has already reached the minimum time limit, while two long whistle blasts indicate that they already reached the maximum time.
5. One point will be deducted from the group's score if the performance exceeds six minutes. One point will also be deducted from the group's score if their performance falls below the minimum time allotment.
6. KAB Palabas with musical instruments and or Audio Soundtrack will be allowed.
7. Board of Judges will be determined by the Local Jamboree Organizing Committee.
8. Criteria for judging:

a. Mastery/Overall Performance	=	25%
b. Execution and Stage Appearance (Projection and Synchronization)	=	25%
c. Costume and Resourcefulness	=	25%
d. Entertainment Value (Creativity and Originality)	=	15%
e. Audience Impact	=	10%
TOTAL	=	100%

9. Vulgar, obscene, racially slurred contents and violent scenes are not permitted.
10. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

**GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR YOUR LOOKS SOUNDS FAMILIAR
(Senior/Rover)**

1. School/district must register prior to the competition
2. The contestant must be a duly registered Senior/Rover Scout and is officially a registered participant to the **3rd A HAPPY MISOR SCOUT JAMBOREE**.
3. Only 1 participant per High School/District and may present songs, dance or any desired presentation.
4. The presentation should only be a minimum of 4 minutes and not exceeding 10 minutes.
5. Board of Judges will be determined by the Local Jamboree Organizing Committee.
6. Criteria for judging:

a. Stage Presence/Overall Performance	=	30%
b. Costume and Resourcefulness	=	30%
c. Entertainment Value (Creativity and Originality)	=	30%
d. Audience Impact	=	10%
TOTAL	=	100%

7. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR SCOUTS IDOLS (Boy Scouts)

1. Contestants must be a duly registered Kawan/Boy Scouts and is officially a registered participant to the **3rd A HAPPY MISOR SCOUT JAMBOREE**.
2. Only 1 participant per High School/District and may present songs, dance or any desired presentation.
3. The presentation should only be a minimum of 4 minutes and not exceeding 10 minutes.
4. Board of Judges will be determined by the Local Jamboree Organizing Committee.
5. Criteria for judging:

e. Stage Presence/Overall Performance	=	30%
f. Costume and Resourcefulness	=	30%
g. Entertainment Value (Creativity and Originality)	=	30%
h. Audience Impact	=	10%
TOTAL	=	100%

6. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
