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THIRD INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE
DEVELOPMENT OF ASSOCIATION OF SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS
COACHES OF THE PHILIPPINES (ASMaC)

The Association of Science and Mathematics Coaches (ASMaC) of the Philippines, together with the International Association of Mathematics Science Educators and ASMaC International Institute, will conduct its *Third International Conference on Education for Sustainable Development* with the theme *Educational Leaders Transcending the Challenges of 2015 ASEAN Integration* from October 25 to 27, 2015 at the Punta Villa Resort, Arevalo, Iloilo City.

The Conference aims to:

1. enable the participants to acquire deep understanding of the Philosophy of Education for Sustainable Development;
2. help them gain understanding on how they can transcend the challenges of the 2015 ASEAN Integration;
3. provide them with an opportunity to present their research paper and best practices; and
4. recognize outstanding Science and Mathematics coaches.

During the Conference, there will be a presentation on Research Paper, Best Practices in School Administration and Best Practices in Classroom Learning Management by the nominees to the 2015 Most Outstanding Science and Mathematics Coaches of the Philippines. Interested participants may submit their research abstract containing not more than 200 words on or before *August 15, 2015* and send to asmacphilippines@gmail.com. Presentors with accepted paper will be informed through email on or before *August 31, 2015*. Likewise, selected paper will be published in a journal or in a book. The final interview will be held on *October 25-27, 2015*. The awarding ceremony of the *2015 Most Outstanding Science and Mathematics Coaches of the Philippines* will be on the last day of the Conference.

The target participants are Science and Mathematics teachers and school administrators from both public and private schools.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
