1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 7, 1994 declaring the month of November of every year as "Filipino Values Month" and per Regional Memorandum No. 65 dated July 29, s. 2015 entitled "Regional Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition", the Curriculum Implementation Division in this office will conduct "Division Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition on November 9, 2015 at Misamis Oriental General Comprehensive High School (MOGCHS) from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

2. The theme for the said activity is "**Sa K to 12: Kayang-kaya, Sama-Sama.**"

3. The celebration aims to enable participants to:

a) provide better understanding on the importance of values education in transforming a humane society;

b) demonstrate commitment to support the advocacy of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao through healthy and friendly competitions; and

c) enhance talents and skills of student-participants and teacher-coaches in the different contested events by promoting the real Filipino values.

4. The different events to be contested both in elementary and secondary levels are **essay writing in Filipino, minus one praise song, on-the-spot poster making contest and tagis-talino**. It is emphasized that no contestant shall be participating two events.

6. Traveling expenses will be charged to school downloaded fund/MOOE or SEF subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**SUBJECT :** **Regional Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition**

**Date :** July 29, 2015

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1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 7, 1994 declaring the month of November of every year as "Filipino Values Month", the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) in this Office will conduct "Regional Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition on November 20, 2015 at Regional Education Learning Center (RELC), Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City.
  2. The theme for the said activity is "Sa K to 12: Kayang-Kaya, Sama-Sama."
  3. The celebration aims to enable participants to :
    - a) provide better understanding on the importance of values education in transforming a humane society;
    - b) demonstrate commitment to support the advocacy of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao through healthy and friendly competitions; and
    - c) enhance talents and skills of student-participants and teacher-coaches in the different contested events by promoting the real Filipino values.

4. The different events to be contested both elementary and secondary levels are essay writing in Filipino, minus one praise song, on-the-spot poster making and tagis-talino. It is emphasized that no contestant shall be participating two events. Guidelines and criteria of the contests are herewith attached.
5. It is encouraged that each Division shall conduct its school, district and division level contests. The division first place winners and their coaches will represent during the Regional Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition on November 20, 2015.
6. The participants to this activity are the Division Education Program Supervisors In-charge of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, winning students and pupils in the different levels with their teacher-coaches and identified district and school coordinators in-charge of EsP.
7. Pupils/Students participants shall be given enough time to prepare for quizzes and other examinations missed in their classes during the conduct of the competition. They shall also be allowed reasonable time to comply with and submit other requirements of the different subject areas.
8. Travelling expenses, meals, lodging, and a registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) of each participant for plaques, medals, certificates, cash prizes, honoraria, token of the judges, venue rentals, tarpaulin and other incidental expenses shall be charged against school/local/MOOE/local school board funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is advised that PTA and non-government funds and other funding sources be tapped for financial assistance.
9. Each Division through the Division EsP Coordinator should bring documents duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendent certifying that their contestants are officially enrolled for SY 2015- 2016.
10. The list of division officials, coaches and contestants must be faxed to Telephone No. 088714576 not later than November 5, 2015, c/o The Chief, CLMD, this Office or email to rositayburan@yahoo.com.

**GUIDELINES/MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR  
2015 REGIONAL EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO COMPETITION**

**a) Tagis-Talino**

1. There will be one entry per category (elementary and secondary) composed of three(3) participants in each team/category. For the elementary category, the team is composed of Grade IV, V, & VI pupils while the secondary category is composed of Grade 7, 8, & 9 students.
2. The teams will compete in three rounds, namely, the Essay (1pt), Average( 3pts.) and Difficult ( 5pts.) levels.
3. The questions will be constructed by the Regional Education Program Supervisors In-charge of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao.
4. The contestants shall bring and wear their IDs for checking and verification.
5. The quizmaster will read the questions twice and the team for the quizmaster's signal to raise their answers. The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
6. The five teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners. (Champion, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> Runners-up). The Top 3 teams will receive individual personalized medals with certificates and the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.

**b. Minus-One Praise Song**

1. There will be one entry either male or female per category ( 1-elementary & 1 secondary) every Division.
2. The song must be either English or Filipino and must be a song of praise or worship or religious/inspirational.
3. It must be a whole song and not be remixed.
4. The contestant and the teacher-coach must check the minus one with the sound system in-charge to ensure that the CD/USB is functional and that no vocal/lyrics heard once it is on.

5. The following are the criteria for judging:

Voice Quality	25%
Interpretation	25%
Diction and Clarity	25%
Stage Presence	15%
Audience Impact	10%
Total	100%

6. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> placers will receive personalized medals with certificates while the rest will receive certificates

so with the teacher-coaches.

7. The decision of judges is irrevocable and final.

2. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials.
  - a. ¼ illustration board
  - b. Pencil; and pastel/cray pass
3. The theme/topic shall be given ten (10) minutes before the contest proper. Teacher-coaches can still give their final coaching to the participants before the start of the contest.
4. Contestants are given 1 hour and 30 minutes (1 & 1/2) to finish the work.
5. Letterings and borders are not allowed as part of the presentation
6. All entries shall be judged based on the following criteria:
 

Relevance of the Theme	40%
Creativity	20%
Originality	20%
Visual Impact	20%
Total	100%

**Essay Writing Contest in Filipino**

1. There will be one entry per category ( 1 elementary & 1 secondary) every Division.
2. The contest must be written in Filipino.
3. The contest is simultaneous and the contestants are only given one (1) hour to finish the essay.
4. The essay must have a minimum of 350 words for elementary and 500 words for secondary and not to exceed 700 words for elementary and secondary levels.
5. The theme/topic shall be given ten (10) minutes before the contest proper. Teacher-coaches can still give their final coaching to the participants before the start of the contest. No writing material is allowed during the 10-minute preparation.
6. The criteria of the contest are the following:
 

Content (Relevance to the Theme)	40%
Originality	30%
Structure	15%
Style	15%
Total	100%
7. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> placers will receive personalized medals with certificates while the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.
8. Decision of judges is final and irrevocable.

In order to determine the **Over-all Champion** both elementary and secondary categories, points of 6,5,4,3, and 2 shall be given to the first, second, third, fourth and fifth ranks respectively in Essay Writing, On the Spot Poster Making & Minus-One Praise Song Contests. The non-winners will be given 1 point. In the Tagis-talino, points of 10,9,8,7 shall be given to the first, second, third, fourth and fifth ranks respectively and 5 points shall be given to the non-winners.

**Plaques of Recognition shall be given to the Over- all Champion, First and Second Runner Up.**
