2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015)

- 1. The PSA (Philippine Statistics Authority) call for the support to the **POPCEN 2015** (2015 Census of Population) undertaking by hanging streamer outside the office building. This will intensify awareness and drum up support from the general public.

ANNOUNCEMENT


This is to announce that the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) shall conduct the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015). The enumeration for the POPCEN 2015 is on August 10 to September 6, 2015 in most provinces and may be extended until the end of September 2015 in big cities.

Enumerators wearing official POPCEN 2015 IDs will visit and interview every household to ask basic information such as age, sex, marital status, education, usual occupation and other data. The interview will take from 15 to 30 minutes for each household.

This nationwide activity aims to provide updated population counts of household members as a basis to decision-makers for setting policies in various fields: education, health, welfare, dealing with various levels in the population, housing and development and others.

The PSA call for all to support the POPCEN 2015 by accommodating its enumerators as they do interviews and by providing complete and appropriate answers to all questions during the interview.
