RESEARCH PROJECT ON FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT IN THE

PHILIPPINES BY THE ACTRC

1.The Assessment, Curriculum, and Technology Research Centre (ACTRC), a partnership between the University of the Philippines (UP) and the University of Melbourne, is undertaking the Research Project on Formative Assessment in the Philippines from School Year (SY) 2015-2016 to 2016-2017.

- 2. The Research Project aims to a) describe current classroom environments in the degree to which formative assessment practices are evident; and b) identify strategies which can help teachers in doing formative assessment.
- 3. The target participants are learners and teachers from both public and private elementary and secondary schools in regions under the BEST (Basic Education Sector Transformation) Program. Participation of schools shall be subject to the no-disruptionof-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9,s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
- 4. To generate baseline data on the formative assessment practices of teachers, observation of classes will be conducted in Grades 2, 5 and 8 in the following schools:
