

**REGIONAL RESEARCH CONGRESS

1. DepEd Regional Office through the collaboration of Quality Assurance Division, Curriculum and Learning Management Division and the Policy, Planning and Research Division will hold the Regional Research Congress Cum School-Based Management General Assembly on November 25-27, 2015 to be held at Grand Caprice Convention Center, Limketkai Center, Lapasan , Cagayan de Oro City.
2. The systems and procedures including the criteria set for the research competition shall be in accordance to the ACCESSs principles of School-Based Management:
 - a. Leadership and Governance
 - b. Curriculum and Learning
 - c. Accountability and Continuous Improvement
 - d. Resource Generation
3. The gathering shall be highlighted by the awarding of SBM Accredited Schools, supportive Stakeholders, and the presentation of Continuous Improvement (CI)-based researches of division winners, properly endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendents.
4. Participants to this activity are the Schools Division Superintendents (SDS), Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (ASDS), Regional Chiefs (CLMD, FTAD, HRDD, QAD, PPRD, AD, FD, ESSD), Division Chiefs (CID, SGOD), Education Program Supervisors (Region and Division), Education Program Specialist-Planning & Research, Division SBM Coordinators, Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS), SBM Awardees, Stakeholder-Awardees, and Research Presenters.
5. Research competition shall be in Oral and Poster Presentations. Mechanics are found in the enclosures.
6. Qualifiers for SBM Level of Practices validation, Level II and III shall be given recognition in the evening of Day 2 (November 26, 2015). Principals are required to

represent the school and the community efforts in receiving the Plaque of Recognition. Likewise, they are advised to come in Formal Attire during the Gabi ng Parangal.

7. The List of awardees shall be disseminated through an Advisory. School Heads awardees must attend the whole duration of the congress.
8. Each participant including the SBM Awardees is charged with a registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) to defray the cost of food, prizes, and other operational expenses. Early registration/Advance payment is required to facilitate the requisite resources prior to the actual assembly. Registration at the venue will start at 1 PM on November 25, 2015. First meal and last meal to be served is dinner on November 25 and lunch of November 27, 2015 respectively. Afternoon snacks of November 27 shall still be served.
9. Deadline for early registration/advance payment will be on or before November 9-10, 2015 through the Regional Cashier. The Division SEPS for Planning and Research/Division Research Coordinator will facilitate the collection in their respective division through the Division Cashier.
10. Advance payment will be deposited to the Development Bank of the Philippines.

GUIDELINES

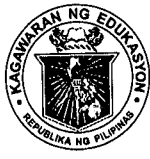
1. Only entries submitted on the set deadline, November 2, 2015, properly endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent shall be considered for the contest.
2. Entries in both oral and poster presentations shall be submitted in three (3) copies, properly labeled using the Research Proforma (Enclosure No. 5)
3. A total of 112 research entries shall be made available for judging.

Strand 1, (Principle 1) Leadership & Governance	14 Divisions
Strand 2, (Principle 2) Curriculum & Learning	14 Divisions
Strand 3, (Principle 3) Accountability and Continuous Improvement	14 Divisions
Strand 4, (Principle 4) Resource Management and Mobilization	14 Divisions
4. Principles 1,3 and 4 shall be coming from School Heads/Supervisors/ Education Program Specialists while entries for Principle 2 shall be from Teachers.
5. All Division winners will receive a Certificate of Recognition and Cash Awards.
6. Winners for Oral and Poster Presentation in the Regional Level will receive Cash Awards (1st place to 5th place)
7. Entries for each strand in the Oral Category will be trimmed down into five (5) which will be identified by the Regional Committee. Identified entries will be disseminated through an advisory.
8. Judging shall be done following this criteria:

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CRITERIA FOR JUDGING THE BEST PAPERS

A. Clear Focus (20%)

Is the topic clear? Is it relevant to the conference theme? Is it clearly introduced at the beginning of the paper? Are the body of the paper and its conclusion clearly related to the topic?

B. Research (25%)

Does the paper contain enough information to back up its ideas? Are there enough sources of information? Are the sources reliable? Are they current? Are they varied and balanced, especially on controversial issues? When appropriate, has the paper used different types of sources such as books, journals, newspapers, interviews, or the internet?

C. Reasoning and Organization (25%)

Are the key concepts defined and presented in a clear way? Does the paper's argument follow a logical outline? Are the parts of the paper coherent? Are they logically connected?

Is information presented clearly? When appropriate, did the paper use statistics, tables, and/or graphs?

D. Documentation (15%)

Is the information documented in the body of the paper? Are the sources cited in the APA Style? Are they in the right places?

Does the paper's "References" page list all the works cited in the paper and no other? Are they cited correctly?

E. Writing Mechanics (15%)

Is the paper free of grammatical, spelling, and typing errors? Are the sentences short, clear, and free of unnecessary jargon?
