This has reference to the implementation of the Scouting Program in the Province of Misamis Oriental and approved conduct of Basic Training Course for Troop/Kawan Leaders pursuant to DepEd Misamis Oriental Division Memorandum No. 292 s. 2016 re: Conduct of Basic Training and Refresher Course.



Some of the districts (Districts of Tagoloan, Manticao and Lugait) were not able to send participants to the above-mentioned Basic Training course hence we are scheduling the conduct of Scouting Basic Training and Refresher Course for the above cited Districts and to all newly hired teachers in the division of Misamis Oriental Both Elementary and High Schools on October 21-23, 2016 at Tagoloan Central School, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental subject to your consideration and approval.

The said training encompasses our desire to strengthen and to advance quality school and community-based scouting program for which adult leaders (Teachers) are the very vital human resource and aims to capacitate and provide new and prospective adult leaders basic training in Scouting, provide update on the new ideas and trends, policies of the BSP and ensure the effective delivery of the Scouting Program and the achievement of BSP Mission.

In consideration of the DepEd Policy on "Time on Task", the Basic Training and Scouting Refresher Course will commence on a Friday at 6:00 PM and will end on a Sunday at 1:00 PM.

As such, a training fee of Four Hundred Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$400.00) will be collected each participant to cover cost of their registration to the BSP which will entitles them to a coverage of one year of its financial assistance program, scout neckerchief and slide, certificate and other operational expenses.

In the activities of this nature, it is suggested that participants must bring their own food provisions, sleeping bags, extra clothes, and personal toilet kit enough to last for the duration of the training. However, meals are available at the canteen and food stalls at participant's costs.
