SUBJECT: 2016 REGIONAL HEALTH AND SUPPORT SERVICES CONGRESS

1. The Department of Education (DepED), Region X, will hold the 2016 Regional School Health and Support Services Congress with theme “ **Quality Service Towards Progressive Region X**” on August 18 -19, 2016 venue to be announced.

3. The above division/ school personnel are advised to attend on **official business**.
4. Each participant will be charged **Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500.00)** as payment for Registration Fee to cover board and lodging, hand outs, kits, CDs and workshop supplies and materials.
Travel expenses and registration fees of participants shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
Travel expenses and registration of health personnel from the division office may also be charged to savings of the Health and Nutrition Program funds and from other local funds, while health personnel from public secondary school shall charge their expenses to their own school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
Any proceeds for registration fee shall be used for honoraria of guest speakers, facilitators, moderators and working committees, and other expenses relative to the conduct of the Congress.
5. Participants are expected to check in after lunch on August 17, 2016 and check out after snack in the afternoon of August 19, 2016. First meal served will be dinner on August 17, 2016.
