1. This office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) – Learning Resource Management Section (LRMS) announces the conduct of **Gawad Teodora Alonso (GTA) 2024 (6th National Competition on Storybook Writing)**. **Deadline of submission of entries will be on August 30, 2024.**
2. The GTA 2024 aims to:
 - a. appreciate the role of stories and illustrated storybooks as tools in the development of reading and of learning curricular content standards;
 - b. harvest original stories that demonstrate learning competencies of the K to 10 MATATAG curriculum;
 - c. recognize the skills and talents of classroom teachers, non-teaching personnel, education leaders, and learners in the production of storybooks for basic education; and
 - d. contribute to the treasury of content materials for utilization as reading resources and transformation to engaging media.
3. The following are the categories:
 - a. Category 1 (Storybooks for Young Readers) – Storybooks for Grades 4, 5 and 6; Original illustrated children’s stories based on the MATATAG curriculum with themes of local culture; open for DepEd teachers and non-teaching personnel, and fulltime non-DepEd and private school teachers of basic education;
 - b. Category 2 (Storybooks for Emergent Readers) – Wordless storybooks on the MATATAG curriculum for kindergarten education; open for DepEd teachers and non-teaching personnel, and fulltime non-DepEd and private school teachers of basic education;
 - c. Category 3 (Storybooks for Beginning Readers) – Story for Grades 1, 2 and 3; Original children’s story manuscripts based on the MATATAG curriculum with themes of local culture; open for DepEd teachers and



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non-teaching personnel; (*Participants in other categories can no longer join this category*)

- d. Category 4 (Storytelling Sessions) – Recorded storytelling or multi-media formats of original stories addressing: inclusive education and gender and development, environment and disaster risk management, and family and mental health; open for DepEd teachers and non-teaching personnel, tandems or teams of DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel, and inclusion of learners as participants with consent from legal guardians; and
 - e. Category 6 (Stories for Young Readers by Young Writers) – Original children’s stories based on learner’s experiences relating to DepEd Core Values Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan, at Makabansa; open for Grades 4-12 learners in any DepEd basic education school, with consent from legal guardians, DepEd teachers and non-teaching personnel of the same school as the participant serving as writing coach.
