SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL -BASED FEEDING (SBFP) FOR SY 2016 -2017

- I. In consonance with **DepED ORDER No. 51, s. 2016** dated June 29, 2016 entitled **Implementation of School - Based Feeding Program for SY 2016 -2017**, School - Based Feeding Program should be implemented to address undernutrition and short term hunger among public school children.
- II. The program aims to improve the Nutritional Status of the beneficiaries by at least **70%** at the end of the **120 feeding days** and to increase classroom attendance by **85%**. It also aims to develop good health habits and positive values of the school children.
- III. Target beneficiaries are the severely wasted and wasted pupils based on the baseline Nutritional Status for the school year 2016 -2017.
- IV. A budget of **P18.00** (P16.00 for food and P2.00 for operational expenses) is allotted per beneficiary for **120 feeding days**.
- V. All beneficiaries should be dewormed prior to feeding.
- VI. School Heads should monitor the daily implementation of the feeding activities while the Division TWG should monitor the school compliance with guidelines, procurement process, health and nutrition assessment, and the conduct of other complementary activities.
- VII. Feeding should start not later than **September 19, 2016** to end up **March 29, 2016**.
- VIII. At the end of the program all implementing schools are required to submit Program Terminal Report to the head of the School Division Technical Working Group. (SDTWG).
- IX. Attached is the list of SBFP recipient schools for SY 2016 – 2017.
