Subject: re: Sagip Isports the 3S –Sustainable Sports Specialization

1. Per Regional Memorandum No. 82, s. 2013 re: Sagip Isports the 3S –Sustainable Sports Specialization through School Sports and Special Events Group (SSSEG) of Promotional Division Region X shall reiterate the strong implementation of Sagip Isports program between school/division and local (municipal/provincial) government unit as articulated in Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013.
2. To sustain the status of performance in the Palarong Pambansa, the regional office shall reinforce the institutionalization of Sagip Isports the 3S – Sustainable Sports Specialization as an intervention in the school sports program which shall be adopted by public schools for elementary and secondary levels.
3. The program aims to:
 - 3.1 Sustain the level of sports performance in the national arena;
 - 3.2 Enhance the skills of student athletes through supervised intensive training;
 - 3.3 Provide benefits to athletes and coaches in their active participation to sports.
