Reiterating CSC NO. 14 and 25 S. 1991 re. Dress code Prescribed

for all Government Officials and Employees

- 1. In line with the provisions of RA 6713 (Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees) and in order to maintain modesty and proper decorum in the civil service, the Civil Service Commission being the central personnel agency of the Government, hereby prescribed the following as the Dress Code for all government officials and employees in the government service when reporting for work, thus:
- 2. The office uniforms as prescribed by the different government agencies/offices shall be the official attire of all government officials and employees, which shall be worn in accordance with their assigned schedule.
- 3. On those days when there is no prescribed uniform for the day, employees shall be dressed in appropriate business attire.
- 4. All school heads are reminded that starting August 1, 2016 was the wearing of our prescribed office uniform for the School Year 2016-2018. *Please refer to DepEd Memo No. 84, s.2016.*
