September 9-11, 2016


Venue: Jasaan Central School, Jasaan, Misamis Oriental

In consideration of the DepEd Policy on "Time on Task", the Basic Training and Scouting Refresher Course will commence on a Friday at 6:00 PM and will end on a Sunday at 1:00 PM.

As such, a training fee of Four Hundred Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}400.00) will be collected each participant to cover cost of their registration to the BSP which will entitles them to a coverage of one year of its financial assistance program, scout neckerchief, carabao slide, certificate and other operational expenses.

In the activities of this nature, it is suggested that participants must bring their own food provisions, sleeping bags, extra clothes, and personal toilet kit enough to last for the duration of the training. However, meals are available at the canteen and food stalls at participant's costs.
